Program Overview

Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is envisaged by the Government of India to provide drinking water supply to every rural household in adequate quantity of prescribed quality at affordable service delivery charges on regular and long-term basis, thereby improving the standard of living of rural communities can be improved. The mission is also focused on to implement source sustainability measures as mandatory elements that include recharge and reuse through grey water management, water conservation and rainwater harvesting among the others. Extensive information, education, stakeholder training and communication are the key components of the mission.

Three-day executive development program on “Operation and Maintenance of Rural water supply schemes, Source Sustainability & Recharge of spring water sources” is proposed from 27 May to 29 May 2024 in Sikkim.

50 mid-level government officials including Executive Engineers, Assistant Engineers, District Coordinators and Junior Engineers etc from Rural Development Department (RDD) have been expected in 3 days residential training program. The major objective of the program would be to convey the attention of Public Health Engineers on the Operation and Maintenance of water supply systems, Utility approach & tariff collection mechanism in the country.

Mode of teaching

Power point presentation, field visit, discussions, group work and lectures

- Icebreaking and Expectations: Interactive activity to introduce participants and set session expectations.
- Overview of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM): Introduction to JJM program objectives and change management.
- Springshed Management: Planning and implementation strategies for source sustainability.
- Exposure Visit: Visit a site implementing the springshed model for practical insights.
- Yoga Session: Morning yoga and recap of previous day's activities.
- Integrated Water Resource Management (IWRM): Basic concepts for sustainable water management and Source Sustainability in Hilly Areas for long-term water source sustainability.
- Case Study of Dhara Vikas: Learnings from Dhara Vikas' springshed initiatives.
- Geohydrology Concepts: Mapping and groundwater management techniques for source sustainability.
- Institutional Mechanism: Roles and responsibilities of stakeholders in JJM.
- VWSC and Panchayat Roles: Reorganization and responsibilities of VWSC/Pani Samiti.
