
Activity detail:

First day Program was started with formal inauguration and sessions were conducted on Change Management- Role (as Public Health Engineer) and Activities for HAR GHAR JAL, Change Management in JJM, focusing on institutional mechanisms and stakeholder roles. He then addressed water quality monitoring and surveillance, discussing contamination, its adverse health effects, and demonstrating practical use of field testing kits. On the second day overview of water treatment and disinfection technologies, emphasizing the importance of chlorination, focused on participatory approaches for O&M under JJM, including social and behavioral change communication and participatory rural appraisal tools, introduced grey water management technologies, discussing the net zero concept, conventional and advanced treatment techniques, and nature-based solutions. The EDP was concluded with participants' findings, learnings, and feedback of the session along with certificate distribution ceremony.

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Executive Development Program

Change Management- Role (as Public Health Engineer) and Activities for HAR GHAR JAL

Target District: Haridwar and Dehradun

Program Duration: 2 Days

Expected participants: 50

Category: Government officials and engineers

Program Overview

Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is envisaged by the Government of India to provide drinking water supply to every rural household in adequate quantity of prescribed quality at affordable service delivery charges on regular and long-term basis, thereby improving the standard of living of rural communities can be improved. The mission is also focused on to implement source sustainability measures as mandatory elements that include recharge and reuse through grey water management, water conservation and rainwater harvesting among the others. Extensive information, education, stakeholder training and communication are the key components of the mission.

Two-days executive development program on “Change Management- Role (as Public Health Engineer) and Activities for HAR GHAR JAL” is proposed from 15th July to 16th July 2024 in Dehradun, Uttarakhand.

50 mid-level government officials including Executive Engineers, Assistant Engineers, District Coordinators and Junior Engineers etc from Uttarakhand Peyjal Nigam, Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan, along with Panchayat Raj Department and District Water and Sanitation Mission (DWSM) members of District Haridwar and Dehradun have been expected in 2 days residential training program. The major objective of the program would be to equip participants with knowledge on the "Har Ghar Jal" initiative, O&M aspects, change management, aquifer recharge technologies, community engagement, sustainable water practices, and springshed management.

Mode of teaching

Power point presentation, discussions, group work and lectures

Program Coverage:

- Issues, Challenges & Functionality Assessment: Identify and assess the key challenges and functionality gaps in rural water supply systems under JJM.
- Change Management in JJM, Institutional Mechanism: Discuss strategies for managing change and the institutional framework supporting JJM implementation.
- Role of Various Stakeholders in JJM: Understand the roles and responsibilities of stakeholders involved in the Jal Jeevan Mission.
- Water Quality Monitoring and Surveillance: Explore methods for monitoring water quality and establishing effective surveillance systems.
- O&M of Rural Water Supply Schemes (Preventive & Curative): Learn techniques for preventive and curative maintenance of rural water supply systems.
- Establishment of Operation & Maintenance System: Understand how to set up an effective O&M system for sustainable water supply management.


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- Participatory Approaches for O&M under Jal Jeevan Mission: Learn how to engage communities in the O&M of water supply systems under JJM.
- Treatment and Disinfection of Water Supply (WS): Discuss water treatment and disinfection methods for safe drinking water.
- Rainwater Harvesting: Explore rainwater harvesting techniques as an essential part of water management.
- Long-term Sustainability of Sources (Hill Perspective): Address challenges and solutions for ensuring long-term sustainability of water sources in hilly areas.
- Grey Water Management & Technologies: Understand technologies for effective management of grey water in rural areas.
- Decentralized Management, Convergence and Dovetailing and 15th Finance Commission: Learn about decentralized water management and funding support from the 15th Finance Commission.
- Digital Transformation under JJM: Explore how digital tools and technology are transforming water supply systems under JJM.
- Open Session: Field-Related Issues & Solutions: Address field-specific issues and practical solutions based on real-world experiences.
- Feedback & Certificate Distribution: Gather participant feedback and distribute certificates of completion. Feedback & Certificate distribution

Program Goals:

- Participants will understand the initiative to comprehend the goals, scope, and importance of the "HAR GHAR JAL" initiative & the challenges associated with water scarcity, and the significance of providing clean water to every household.
- Training covers technical, financial and Institutional aspects related to Operation and Maintenance.
- To understand the concept of Change management towards Water supply Management and role & responsibilities as a public health engineer.
- To share the concept and process of direct injection technology for aquifer recharging and its application including creating awareness on RWH and source sustainability measures & orientation on new & traditional technologies of RWH for source.
- Training should include strategies for community engagement, awareness campaigns, and mechanisms for involving local stakeholders in decision-making processes.
- Training emphasizes sustainable practices, water conservation techniques, and effective water resource management strategies.
- The participants will understand the various techniques for Spring shed Management and interventions for revival of water bodies and their source sustainability.

Expected outcomes

- Increased Understanding of the "Har Ghar Jal" Initiative: Participants will gain clarity on the goals, scope, and significance of the initiative, along with the challenges posed by water scarcity and the importance of providing clean water to every household.
- Enhanced Knowledge of Operation & Maintenance (O&M): Attendees will be equipped with the technical, financial, and institutional knowledge required for effective O&M of water supply systems.
- Improved Understanding of Change Management in Water Supply: Participants will learn how to manage change effectively within the context of water supply management and understand their roles and responsibilities as public health engineers.
- Awareness of Direct Injection Technology and Aquifer Recharge: Participants will become familiar with direct injection technology for aquifer recharging, including rainwater


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harvesting (RWH) techniques, and understand both new and traditional technologies for source sustainability.

- Skills for Community Engagement and Stakeholder Involvement: Participants will learn strategies for engaging local communities, raising awareness, and involving stakeholders in decision-making processes related to water management.
- Promotion of Sustainable Water Management Practices: The training will foster an understanding of sustainable water conservation techniques and effective water resource management strategies to ensure long-term water security.
- Practical Knowledge on Springshed Management and Source Revival: Attendees will understand the various techniques for springshed management, including interventions for the revival of water bodies and ensuring the sustainability of water sources.
