

The Curriculum Implementation Support Program (CISP) Workshop: 11th to 12th July 2024



The Curriculum Implementation Support Program in MET was held from 11th to 12th July 2024, at HIMS, Dehradun. A total of 30 faculty members participated in the CISP held from 11th to 12th July 2024, from various Medical Colleges allocated to this Regional Centre. The schedule followed for the workshop was as recommended by NMC. All sessions were facilitated in a highly interactive mode, sparking energetic discussions and enthusiastic participation from all participants. The workshop focused on educators and learners to successfully implement the new curriculum through the adoption of competency-based medical education (CBME), fostering a culture of excellence in medical education and practice. While participants valued the student-doctor teaching approach, they highlighted the need for more dedicated time for clinicians to facilitate small group discussions and bedside teaching, as current time constraints can hinder its success. The session covered the New Graduate Medical Education Regulations (GMER 2019), including the integration of training methods, assessment strategies, and new components such as the Foundation Course and formative feedback. The workshop concentrated on advanced teaching-learning strategies and included a specialized session on the AETCOM module, designed to foster proficient communication skills in a supportive learning environment. The dynamic group activities facilitated a collaborative environment, encouraging participants to freely share their thoughts and insights, leading to a diverse array of ideas and suggestions that significantly contributed to the workshop's success and outcomes. However, participant's boundless energy and enthusiasm were a true asset to the workshop, helping in a collaborative and successful experience.
