

The Curriculum Implementation Support Program (CISP) Workshop: 12th to 13th June 2024



The Curriculum Implementation Support Program in MET was held from 12th to 13th June 2024, at HIMS, Dehradun. A total of 30 faculty members participated in the CISP held from 12th to 13th June 2024, from various Medical Colleges allocated to this Regional Centre. The schedule followed for the workshop was as recommended by NMC. All sessions were moderated in an interactive mode, encouraging dynamic discussions and active participant engagement. The workshop aimed to support a seamless transition to the new curriculum by introducing the principles and practices of competency-based medical education (CBME), thereby enhancing the learning experience and improving patient care. Participants appreciated the student-doctor method of teaching, but noted that time constraints often limited clinicians' availability for small group discussions and bedside teaching, posing a challenge to its effective implementation. New Graduate Medical Education Regulations (GMER 2019) was discussed along with the training methods integrating assessment and additions like Foundation Course and formative feedback. The workshop emphasized innovative teaching-learning methodologies and featured a dedicated session on the AETCOM module, aimed at enhancing communication skills through effective training. The engaging group activities sparked lively discussions, fostering an environment where participants felt empowered to share their perspectives and expertise, resulting in a vibrant exchange of ideas and a plethora of innovative suggestions that greatly enhanced the workshop's value and impact.
