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REPORT OF WORKSHOP ON INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT OF NEONATAL AND CHILDHOOD ILLNESS (IMNCI)

The Child Health Nursing Department, HCN organized a workshop on “**Integrated Management of Neonatal and Childhood Illness (IMNCI)**” on 22nd May, 2024 in Himalayan College of Nursing. The objective of the workshop was to upgrade the skills of beneficiaries about IMNCI. The workshop started at 8:30 am with registration and pretest done through Google form. Dr. Dipti Y Sorte welcomed participants and provided a brief introduction of the topic. There were five workstations handled by faculty as facilitators. The workstation are as follows:

1. Work Station 1: Assessment of sick infant and child, Classify the
2. Work Station 2: Identification and management of Diarrhoea (Infant and young children)
3. Work Station 3: Identification and management of Malaria (Infant and young children)
4. Work Station 4: Identification and management of Anemia (Infant and young children)
5. Work Station 5: Identification and management of Malnutrition (Infant and young children)

There were 141 participants from B.Sc. Nursing V Semester, They were divided into five groups and rotated to each station for 45 minutes. Each work station has assigned facilitator who demonstrated the procedure to the beneficiaries with adequate explanation and re-demonstration was also taken from the students on each stations. After completion of workstations, scenario based skills as above-mentioned topic were given to participants. They performed given task skillfully to the facilitator. At the end, students performed role play on steps of IMNCI and use of color code. Students were very enthusiastic and participated actively throughout workshop. Workshop ended with post-test, feedback and vote of thanks.
