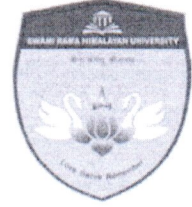

Topic: “Surgical Intervention in Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease.”

Abstract: : A multicentre study from the Indian Society of Gastroenterology Task Force showed a prevalence of 7.6%, while other regional studies in India reported a prevalence of the order of 18.7%. Approximately 70% of these patients are well controlled throughout life with proton pump inhibitors (PPIs). Progression of GERD is limited to the approximately 30% of GERD patients in whom PPI therapy fails to control symptoms. For these patients Anti reflux surgery is recommended. 50% of GERD patients are associated with hiatal hernia. Hiatal hernia (HH) is a common structural defect of the esophageal hiatus with a variety of symptoms ranging from heartburn to dysphagia. Most of these hernias are small, with approximately 95% consisting of the sliding type (type 1 hernia) and often being asymptomatic. Treatment consists of lifestyle changes and medical treatment, with surgery being utilized in cases where the aforementioned proves ineffective. Laparoscopic Fundoplication is done for these cases.

In this CGR we are presenting the case of Refractory GERD with Lax GE Junction+ Hiatal Hernia with Ineffective Esophageal Motility who underwent Toupet Fundoplication.
