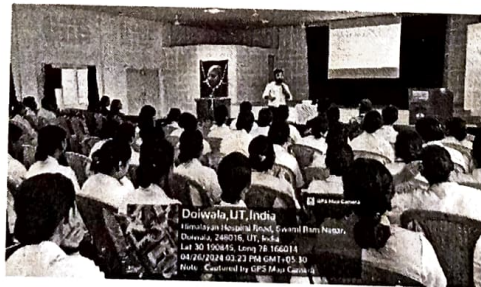
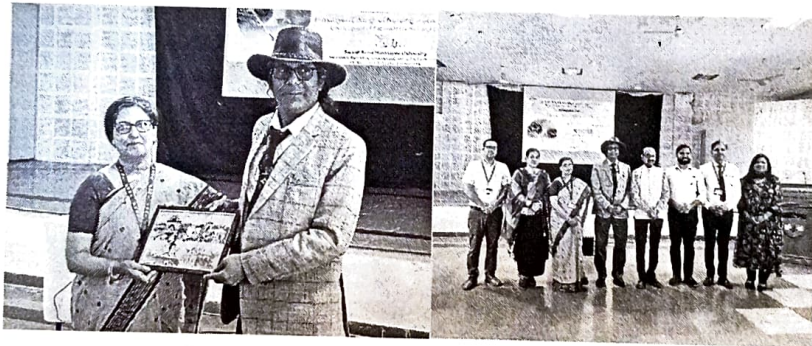


Seminar on Forensic Nurse: The Empowered Caregiver
