The Continuing Nursing Education Department of Himalayan College of Nursing organized a seminar on April 25, 2025. Mrs. Upma George led a session titled "Climate Change: A Threat to Maternal and Neonatal Wellbeing." She discussed how climate change, driven by rising temperatures and extreme weather events, poses significant risks to both maternal and neonatal health. Pregnant women are increasingly at risk of heat stress, dehydration, and complications such as preterm labor and gestational hypertension. Newborns are also vulnerable, facing challenges like low birth weight, respiratory issues from air pollution, and infections linked to water scarcity and poor sanitation. She stressed the importance of early detection, education, and community involvement in addressing these risks. She also encouraged healthcare professionals to advocate for stronger policies and better resources to protect at-risk populations from the adverse effects of climate change on maternal and neonatal health. A total of 22 faculty members benefited from the session, which was well-received.
