Abstract:

Trauma patients constitute a significant portion of the patient load in emergency departments worldwide. Motor vehicle accidents are the most common cause of life-threatening trauma, including suicide and homicide attempts. In India, road traffic accidents are the leading cause of death among the younger demographic- often the primary breadwinners- resulting in substantial social and economic burdens due to loss of productive life years. This emphasizes the urgent need to strengthen transport infrastructure and enhance medical services to reduce trauma-related morbidity and mortality.

The Emergency Medicine Department presents a challenging case of life-threatening trauma that had come to our department. A 46-year-old male was brought to the emergency by 108 ambulance services in a PERI-ARREST state and shock following an alleged history of RTA. He was resuscitated, and later on patient was discharged home with a good functional outcome.

This case underscores the importance of multidisciplinary coordination in trauma care, enabling the successful management of critically injured patients who might otherwise face severe morbidity or death. Such outcomes highlight the need for ongoing advancements in trauma care and emergency response systems to ensure the best possible outcomes for trauma victims.
