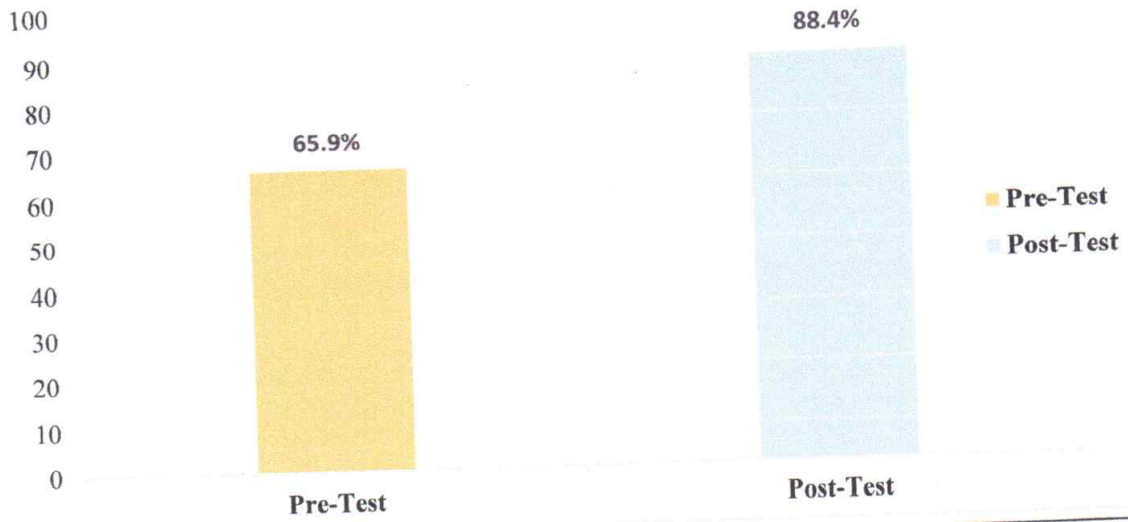
The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecological Nursing, Himalayan College of Nursing (HCN), Swami Rama Himalayan University, successfully organized a Five Days Faculty Development Programme on “*Recent Advances & Simulation-Based Teaching Strategies in Obstetric Emergencies*” from 23rd to 27th February 2026 in blended mode (online and offline), The programme witnessed enthusiastic participation from 350 faculty members representing various nursing institutions across different states of the country.

**On Day 1 (23/02/26), Dr. Lekha Viswanath, Professor cum Principal, Amrita College of Nursing, Amrita University, Faridabad,** provided a comprehensive overview of obstetric emergencies, highlighting maternal mortality trends, early recognition of complications, rapid response systems, and the importance of evidence-based practice; the session was moderated by Dr. Kanchan Bala, Associate Professor, HCN, SRHU. **Day 2 (24/02/26) focused on Obstetric Haemorrhage (Antepartum and Postpartum Haemorrhage),** where **Ms. Ekta Malik, Chief of Academic Initiatives and Simulation,** elaborated on Obstetrical emergencies includes APH and PPH, active management of the third stage of labour, uterotonic drugs, emergency protocols, and team coordination, with moderation by Dr. Anupama Sharma, Assistant Professor, HCN, SRHU. **On Day 3 (25/02/26), Ms. Chhavi Madan, Midwifery Programme Officer, Jhpiego, Punjab,** addressed Labour Room Emergencies including shoulder dystocia, cord prolapse, uterine rupture, and fetal distress, emphasizing simulation drills, communication skills, and structured debriefing; the session was moderated by Mrs. Upma George, Associate Professor, HCN, SRHU.

**Day 4 (26/02/26) featured Dr. Parul Singh, Consultant cum Assistant Professor, Medical College, Muzaffarnagar,** who discussed Medical Emergencies in Pregnancy such as cardiac disorders, anaemia, sepsis, and thromboembolism, stressing interdisciplinary management and referral systems; the session was moderated by Mrs. Shama Praveen, Assistant Professor, HCN, SRHU. **On the final day (27/02/26), Dr. Preety Narula, Professor cum Vice Principal, Gian Sagar College of Nursing, Punjab,** delivered a session on Maternal Collapse and Hypertensive Emergencies including eclampsia management and emergency resuscitation, along with strategies for enhancing teaching skills through OSCEs and competency-based assessment; the session was moderated by Dr. Kanchan Bala, Associate Professor, HCN, SRHU.

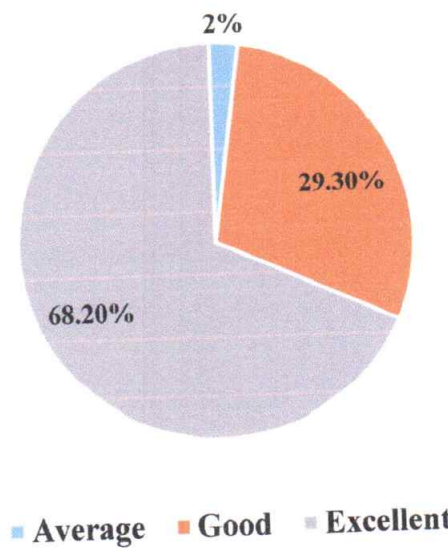
The mean percentage score increased markedly from **65.9% in the pre-test to 88.4% in the post-test,** indicating substantial improvement in participants’ knowledge after the **faculty development programme.** This significant rise reflects the effectiveness of the **faculty development programme** in enhancing understanding and learning outcomes.

**Mean Percentage of Pre-test and Post-test Score**

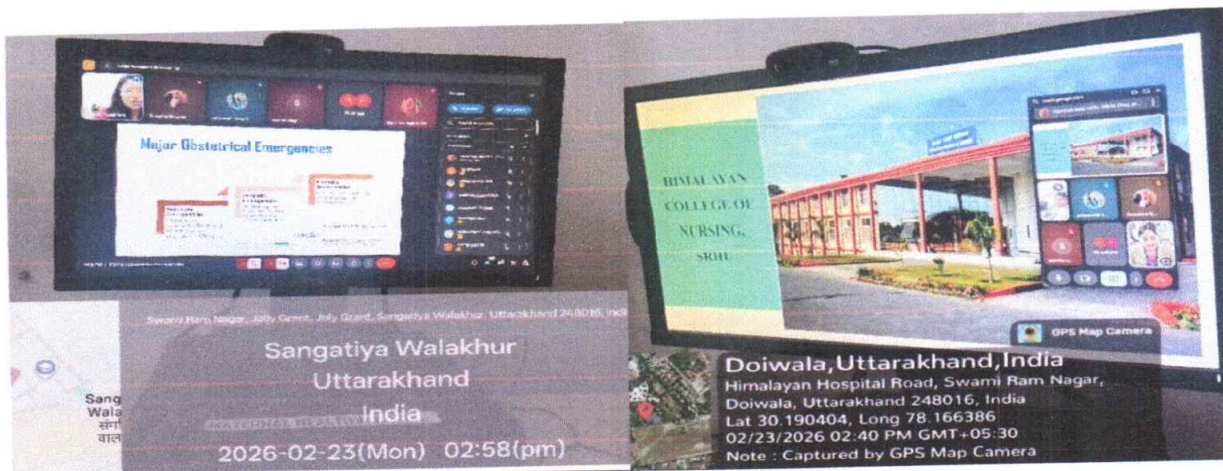


**Bar Graph showing effectiveness of FDP with mean percentage of pretest and posttest score among participants.**

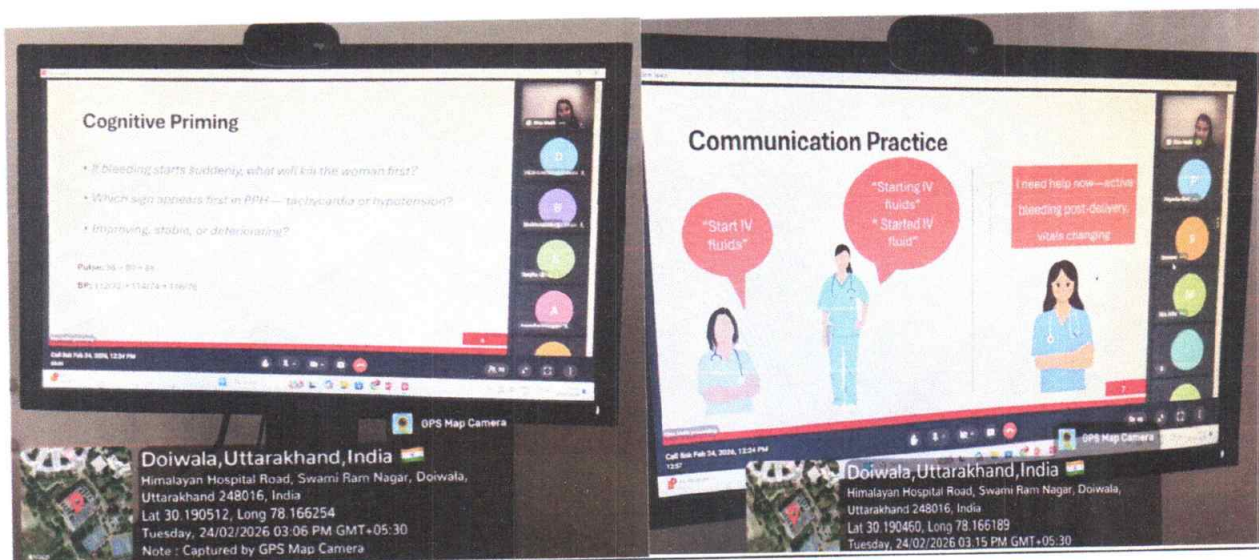
**Feedback of FDP**



**Pie Diagram showing feedback of participants.**



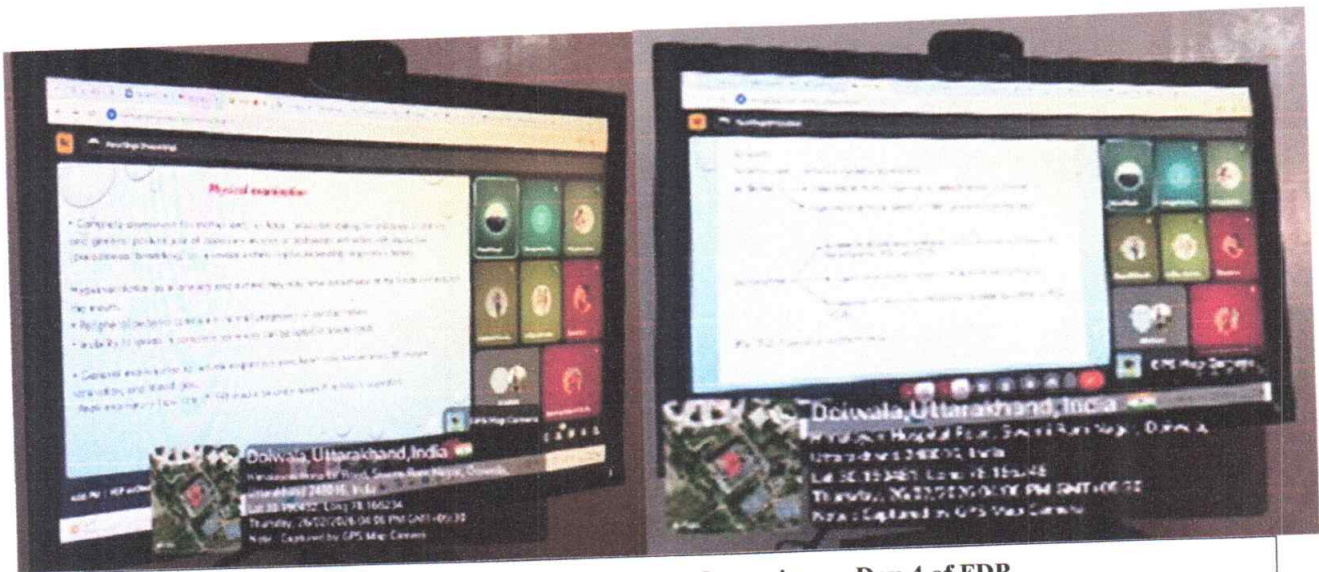
**Pic.1. FDP Day 1 Faculty is giving overview of college and FDP & Speaker is teaching the topic.**



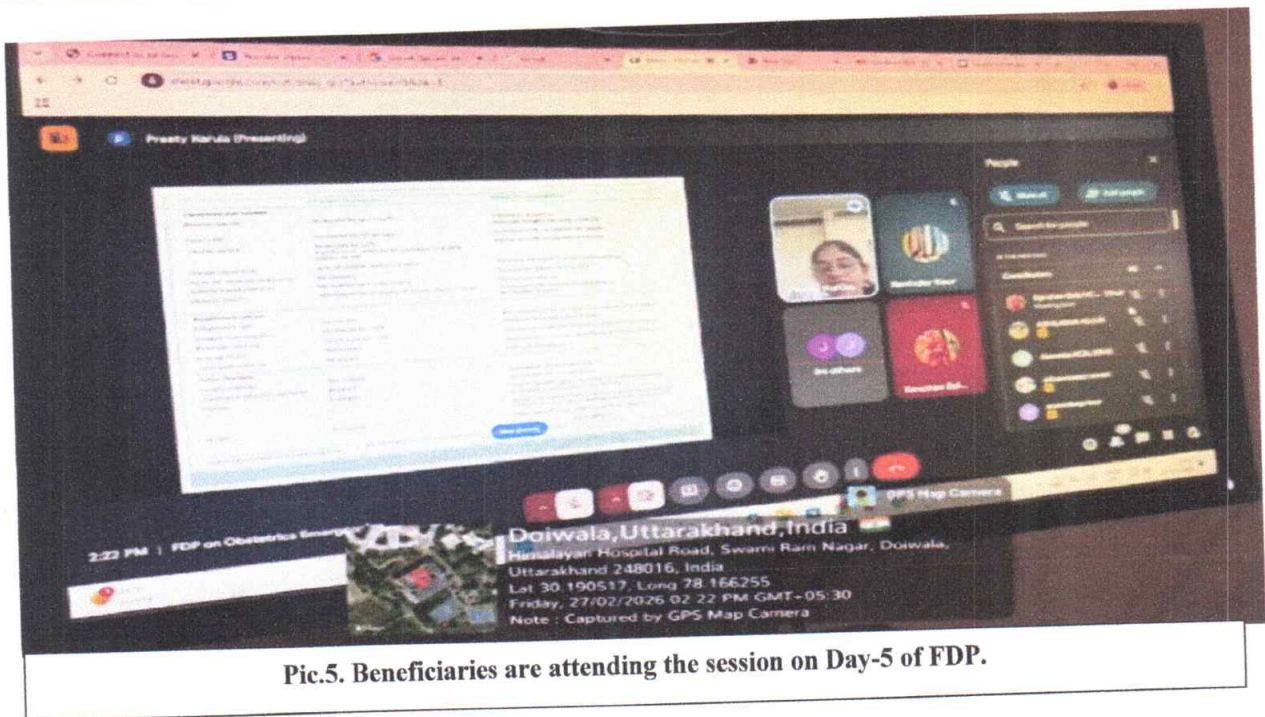
