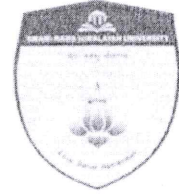

**Abstract:**

Drug-resistant pathogens pose tremendous challenges to the health care system, including challenges related to the diagnosis, treatment, and containment of infections caused by resistant organisms. These challenges are amplified in the intensive care unit (ICU) environment, where pressures for selection and emergence of resistance and the risks of transmission of drug-resistant pathogens are highest, and where the threat of potential drug resistance is a major driver of the selection of empiric antimicrobial regimens. Critical care physicians also face the increasingly common scenario of managing infections caused by organisms, with limited or even no treatment options. Patients with septic shock by multidrug resistant (MDR) microorganism maybe considered a specific population of critical patients at very high risk of death.

In this mortality meet, we will be discussing a case of 33 year old male who was being treated with clostridium difficile diarrhoea in a outside hospital but succumbed to nosocomial infection.
