Abstract:

Cirrhosis is a pathological diagnosis characterized by diffuse fibrosis, severe disruption of the intrahepatic arterial and venous flow, portal hypertension and, ultimately, liver failure. Traditionally, decompensation of cirrhosis is defined by occurrence of ascites, variceal bleed, and/or hepatic encephalopathy. There is agreement that acute on chronic liver failure (ACLF) is not just decompensation of liver cirrhosis, but a distinct syndrome. ACLF is a syndrome characterized by acute and severe hepatic abnormalities resulting from different types of insults in patients with underlying chronic liver disease or cirrhosis. In contrast to decompensated cirrhosis, ACLF has a high short-term mortality, mimicking the prognosis of acute liver failure. In this Clinical Mortality meet, we will be discussing a case of a 48-year-old male with chronic liver disease, who presented with altered sensorium, shock, respiratory failure and metabolic and lactic acidosis.
