

Report: IADVL SIG Dermatopathology CME-cum-Workshop

The Department of Dermatology, in association with Department of Pathology, IADVL SIG Dermatopathology, IADVL National Body, IADVL UP & UK Branch, and the IADVL Dehradun City Chapter, successfully conducted the Dermatopathology CME-cum-Workshop on 16th November 2025 at our institution.
