Abstract:

Through collaborative discussions and case-based presentations involving departments such as surgery, medicine, oncology, urology, neurology, and obstetrics & gynecology, this program will highlight key IR procedures, referral indications, patient selection criteria, and post-procedure care pathways.

The session will emphasize outcomes, safety profiles, and the advantages of minimally invasive IR approaches compared to conventional surgical or medical management. By fostering better communication and referral coordination between departments, the CME seeks to promote early integration of interventional radiology in clinical decision-making, ultimately advancing patient-centered, cost-effective care.
