Report ADRs • Promote Safe Medicines • Strengthen Pharmacovigilance

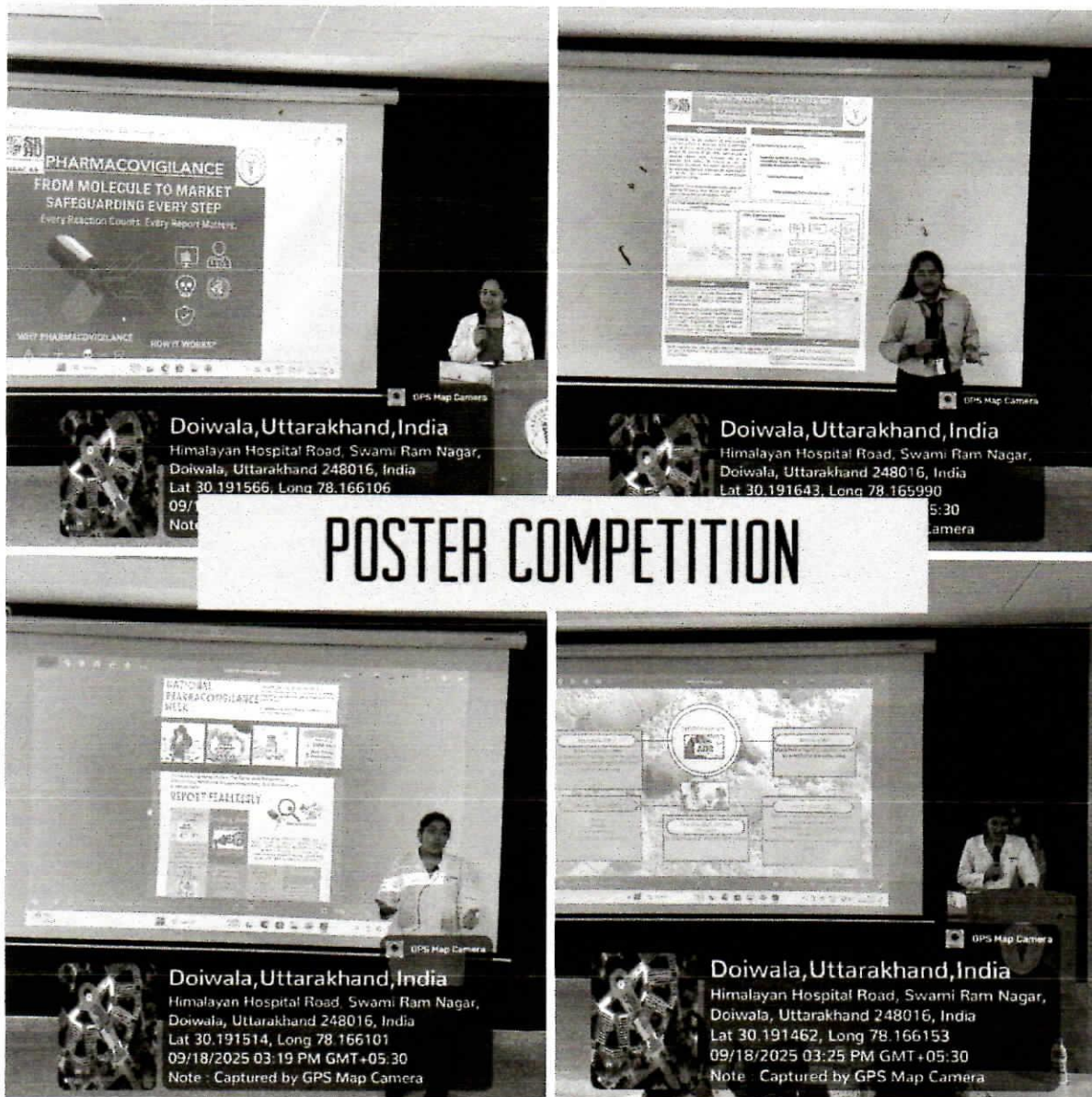
