Topic: Optimizing Care and Comfort: Navigating the Terminal Phase of Advanced Colorectal Cancer

Abstract: This report describes the clinical course of a 54-year-old male patient diagnosed with recurrent, multifocal adenocarcinoma of the colon. Following initial surgical resection and adjuvant chemotherapy in 2020, in 2025 patient experienced recurrent metastatic disease and was lost to follow up after that. He followed up after 3 months with profound metastatic disease. Due to the aggressive nature of the malignancy, and a declining performance status, the patient and their family opted to transition from active oncological treatment to End-of-Life (EOL) care.

Management and Outcomes: The multidisciplinary approach shifted toward rigorous symptom management, prioritizing pain control, psychological support, and the preservation of dignity. The integration of a dedicated palliative care team facilitated honoring the patient's autonomy and quality-of-life preferences
