**REPORT OF INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT OF NEONATAL AND CHILDHOOD
ILLNESS (IMNCI) MODULE**

The Child Health Nursing Department of Himalayan College of Nursing organized a module on "Integrated Management of Neonatal and Childhood Illness" on February 20, 2026 at Mother Teresa Auditorium. The objective of the module was to enhance the skills of participants in management of neonatal and childhood illness. The event commenced at 8:30 AM with the registration of participants, followed by a pre-test conducted via Google Forms. Ms Varsha Rawat welcomed the faculty and participants, providing a brief introduction to IMNCI.

The training was conducted through four interactive workstations:

Workstation 1 – Assessment of sick infant and child & Classify child for possible serious bacterial infection

Workstation 2 – Identification and Management of Malaria (Infant & Young Children)

Workstation 3 – Identification and Management of Anemia (Infant & Young Children)

Workstation 4 – Identification and Management of Malnutrition (Infant & Young Children)

A total of 143 students from the B.Sc. Nursing 6th Semester participated in the module. The module included scenario-based skill demonstrations, video presentations and interactive group activities. Students were shown clinical scenarios related to common childhood illnesses and were guided to assess, classify and manage cases using IMNCI flowcharts.

Overall, the module was successful in improving student's competency, confidence and understanding of IMNCI guidelines for effective child health care management.

The workshop concluded with a post-test, feedback session, and vote of thanks. The event's success was made possible through the efforts of Dr. Sanjenbam Emon Chanu, Dr. Rajkumari Sylvia Devi, Dr. Vandana Chauhan, Mrs. Namrata Pundir, Ms Varsha Rawat and Ms Priya Pal. This workshop proved to be a valuable learning experience, equipping students with IMNCI skills through hands-on training and interactive learning.
