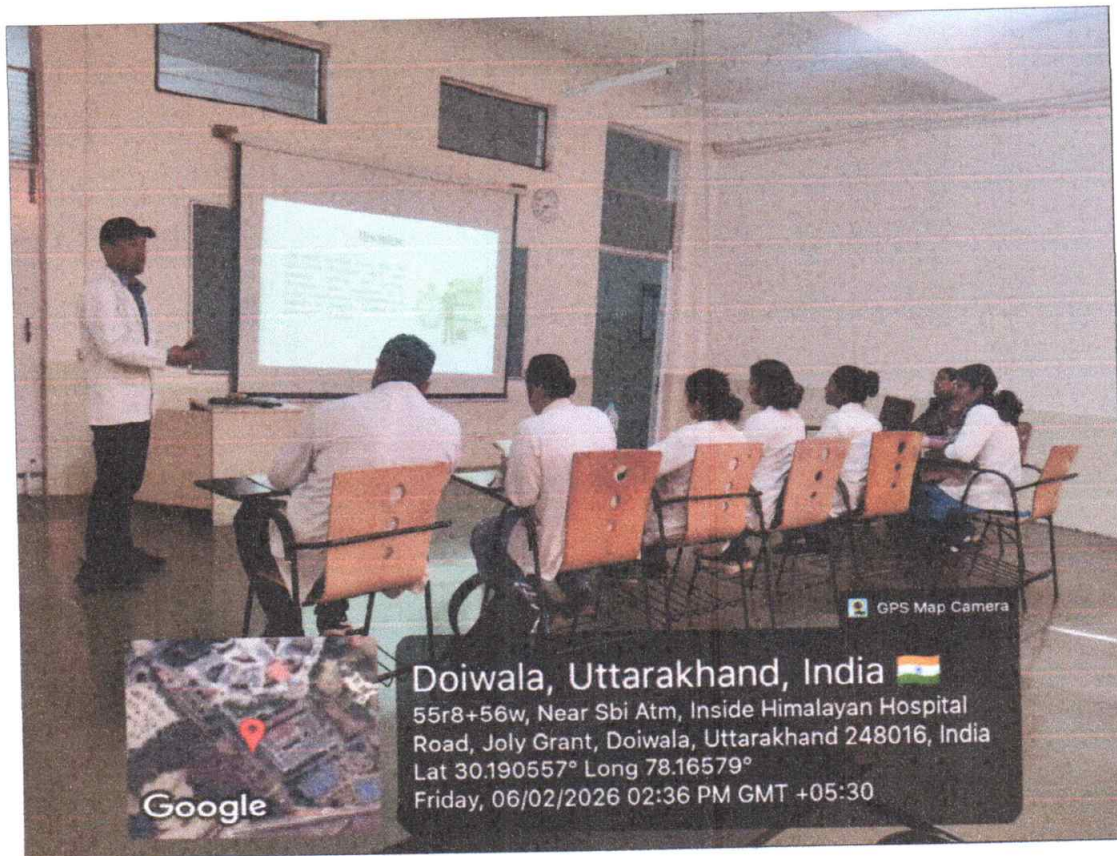

Report of Seminar

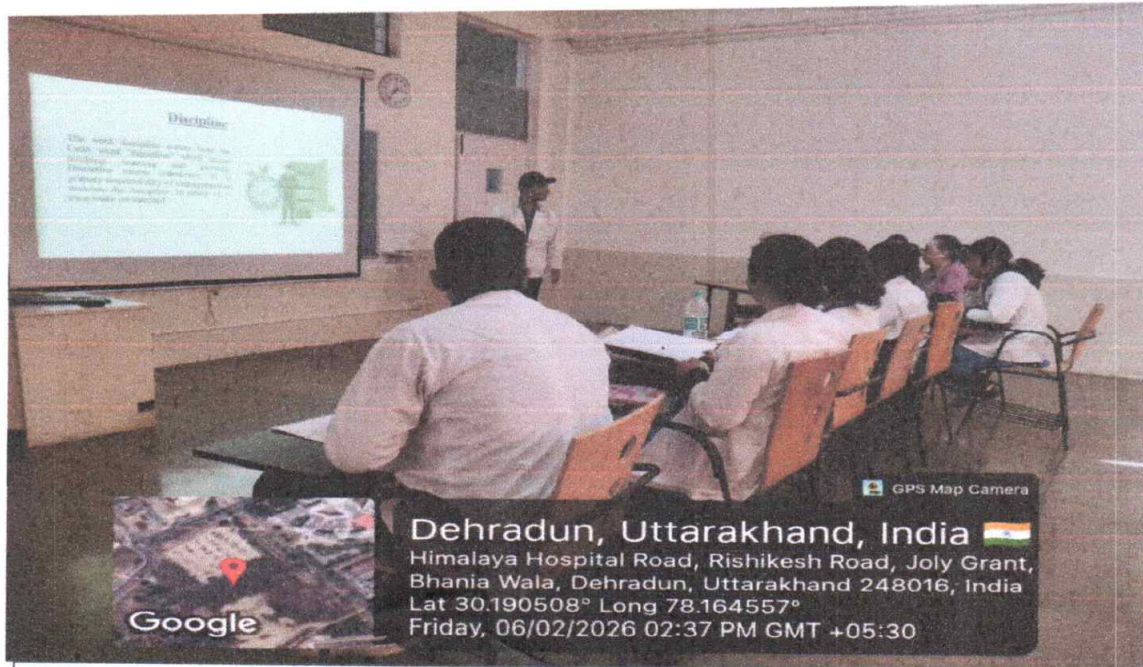
