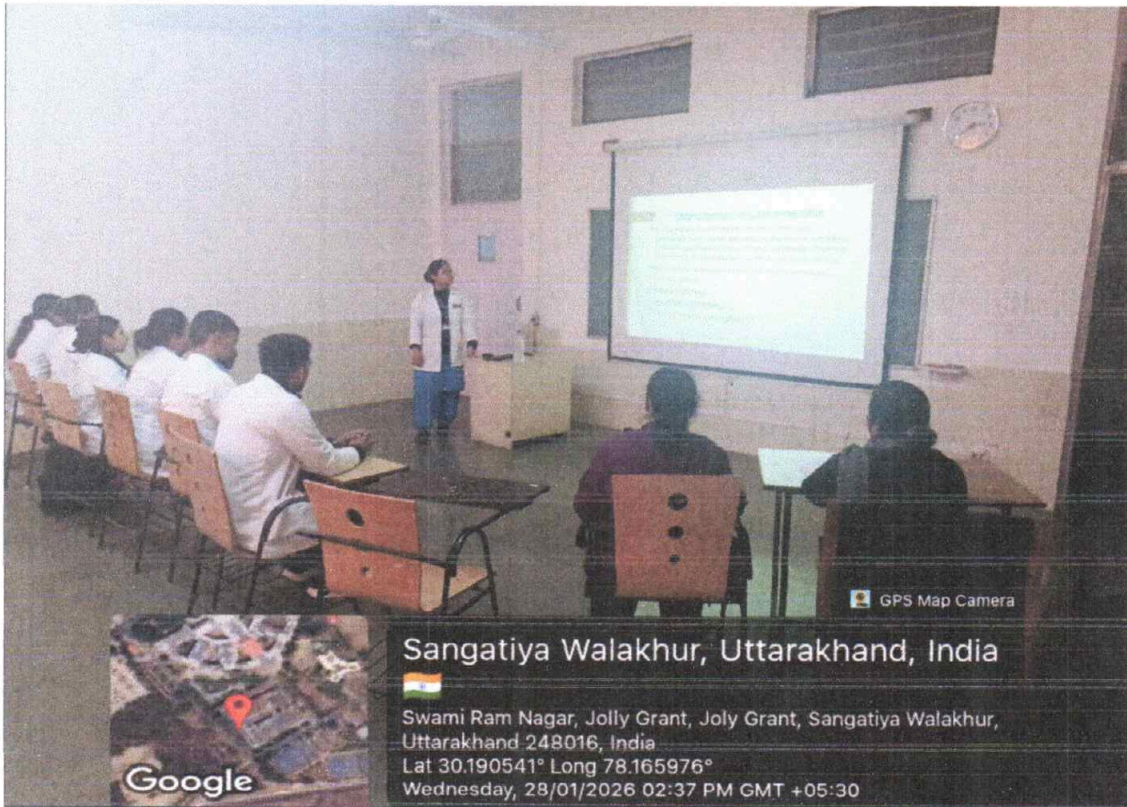
### Report of Seminar

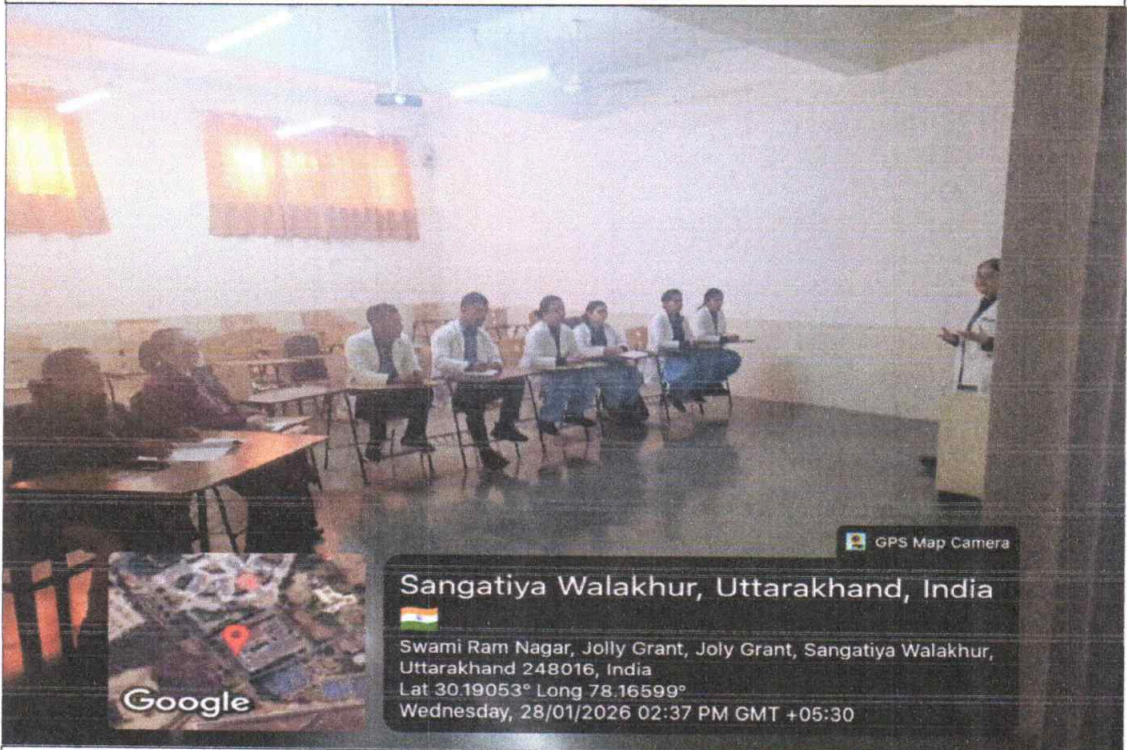






