The session began with a welcome address by Mrs. Shobha Masih Associate Professor, Community Health Nursing Department HCN SRHU

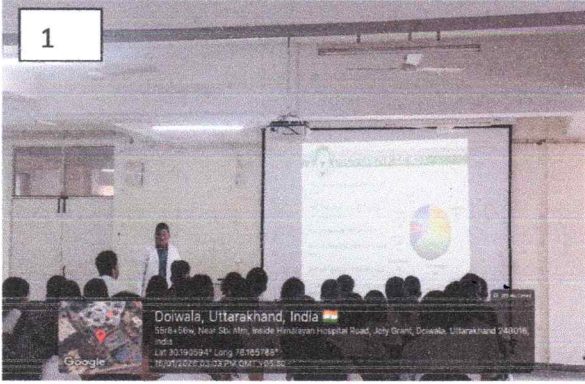
