Phytochemical Analysis of *Diplazium esculentum* Reveals the Presence of Medically Important Components

Abstract: Background: Diplazium esculentum is found throughout Asia growing along with water channels and is used for many purposes. In India, the rhizomes are used to control insects and pests while the young fronds are used as a vegetable and salad. But very few reports on phytochemicals of young fronds and its anti-oxidant activity is available.

Objective: The present study was undertaken to assess the antioxidant, antimicrobial and phytochemical analysis of *D. esculentum*.

Methods: Proximate analysis was done according to the standard protocol while antioxodant and antimicrobial activity was performed by DDPH and well diffusion method respectivity. Phytochemical analysis was performed by GC-MS.

Results: The present study revealed that the young fronds of *D. esculentum* contain high amount of carbohydrate followed by protein, crude fibre, and fat. The free radical scavenging activity of methanolic extract was $87.93 \pm 0.3\%$ reduction, which shows it have potential antioxidant activity. The antioxidant property may be contributed by the presence of phytochemicals such as Phosphoric acid, phytol, 2,6,10-Trimethyl,14 ethylene-14-pentadecene, Hexadecanoic acid methyl ester, Pentadecanoic acid, Stigmasta-5,22-dien-3-ol, acetate, (3.beta.). It showed promising antimicrobial activity against *S. aureus* and *B. subtilis*. The antimicrobial activity may be due to the presence of Phytochemicals such as beta-Ocimene, 2,6,10-Trimethyl,14 ethylene-14-pentadecene, 1,2-Benzenedicarboxylic acid,BIS(2-Methylpropyl)ester, Hexadecanoic acid, methyl ester, 1-Heneicosanol, Phytol, 5,8,11,14-Eicosatetraenoic acid, methyl ester(all Z), 1,2-benzenedicarboxylic acid, Ergost-5-en-3-ol, (3.beta), Stigmasta-5,22-dien-3-ol, acetate, (3.beta.), stigmasta-5,20-dien-3-ol, acetate, (3.beta.), stigmasta-5,20-dien-3-ol, acetate, (3.beta.), stigmasta-5,20-dien-3-ol, (3.beta).

Conclusion: From the present study, it can be deduced that *D. Esculentum* is a rich source of medically important phytochemicals. Further work is required, so that these phytochemicals can be explored in the management of various chronic diseases.

1. INTRODUCTION

Since ancient times plants have been used as a vital resource of nutrition, medicinal products and other life needs. Of all the world's vegetation, Pteridophytes have high economic importance as they are used in a variety of medicament schemes such as Ayurvedic Charak, Suzhrut and Unani medicines [1]. D. esculentum belongs to the family Dryopteridaceae. It is commonly known as Lingura. It is common in Uttarakhand, India and other Asian countries,

especially at low altitudes in Kumaun Himalayas. It grows abundantly alongside water canals. Different parts of the *D. esculentum* are used for many purposes. In the granaries the rhizomes are kept to protect from pests. Another interesting thing is that, *D. esculentum* is one of the most common plants used for restorative purposes and its young fronds are used as green vegetables, salads or foods [2]. It is one of the most popular ferns used for medicine too, its leaves are used for the treatment of cough; decoction of leaves are used to cure cough and sometimes as a tonic and dry rhizomes are used as the bug spray; this plant's extract is now and then used as a tonic to treat hack disease [3-5]. Draft Genome Sequence of Novel *Streptomyces* sp. Strain AJ-1, Isolated from a Leafcutter Ant in Uttarakhand, India

ABSTRACT We present the draft genome sequence of *Streptomyces* sp. strain AJ-1, which was isolated from a leafcutter ant found in Uttarakhand, India. The genome assembly resulted in 43 contigs, with a combined length of 6,948,422 bp and a GC content of 73.5%. Through genome annotation, we identified 5,951 protein-coding genes and 67 tRNA genes.

nts harbor several beneficial microbiomes on their exoskeletons, including Pseudonocardia and Streptomyces species that provide a defense mechanism by producing antimicrobial substances (1-3). The present study was undertaken to isolate antimicrobial agent-producing actinobacteria associated with leafcutter ants in Uttarakhand, India. Ant samples were collected from the Dehradun district of Uttarakhand, India, on 20 December 2019 by using a net and were kept in sterile plastic containers until sacrificed for isolation of actinobacteria. Each ant was crushed in 500 μ L of autoclaved Milli-Q water, the solution was plated on ISP-2 agar (4), and the plates were then incubated at 37°C for 5 to 7 days. The isolate AJ-1 was identified as Streptomyces sp. based on 16S rRNA gene analysis (GenBank accession number OQ256730), and the closest match was found to be Streptomyces daghestanicus NRRL B-5418 (GenBank accession number DQ442497). The actinobacterial culture was grown for 48 h at 30°C in 250-mL flasks containing 40 mL of nutrient broth (pH 7.2), at 180 rpm. The cell biomass was used for extraction of total genomic DNA (gDNA), following the method described by Kumar et al. (5). Briefly, cell biomass was redissolved in Tris-EDTA buffer containing lysozymes (20 mg/mL). After incubation at 37°C for 30 min, it was supplemented with 20 µL of proteinase K (1 mg/mL) and 10% SDS and was incubated at 50°C for 30 min. Phenol-chloroform was added, and the mixture was centrifuged at 10,000 rpm for 5 min at 4°C. The aqueous phase was taken and precipitated with 95% cold ethanol. The DNA was dissolved in DNA/RNA-free water and stored at 4°C until further use.

The gDNA concentration was determined with a Qubit 3.0 fluorometer and a Qubit double-stranded DNA (dsDNA) high-sensitivity (HS) assay kit (Thermo Fischer Scientific). A sequencing library was prepared using the NEBNext Ultra II DNA library preparation kit for Illumina (New England Biolabs). The amplified library was assessed for quantity and quality using a Bioanalyzer 2100 instrument (Agilent Technologies) with a HS DNA chip. Sequencing was conducted on the Illumina HiSeq 4000 platform, generating 6.2 million paired-end reads with an average read length of 151 bp in the 2 × 50-bp format. Trimmomatic v0.40 was utilized to perform quality trimming of the Fastq sequences, with default parameters. FastQC v0.11.2 was employed for quality assessment (https:// www.bioinformatics.babraham.ac.uk/projects/fastqc). *De novo* assembly of the bacterial genome was carried out using Unicycler v0.5.0 with SPAdes as the *de novo* assembler (6). The resulting assembly consisted of 43 contigs, with a total length of 6,948,422 bp, an N_{s0} value of 468,333 bp, a coverage depth of 270.06×, and a GC content of 73.5%. 
