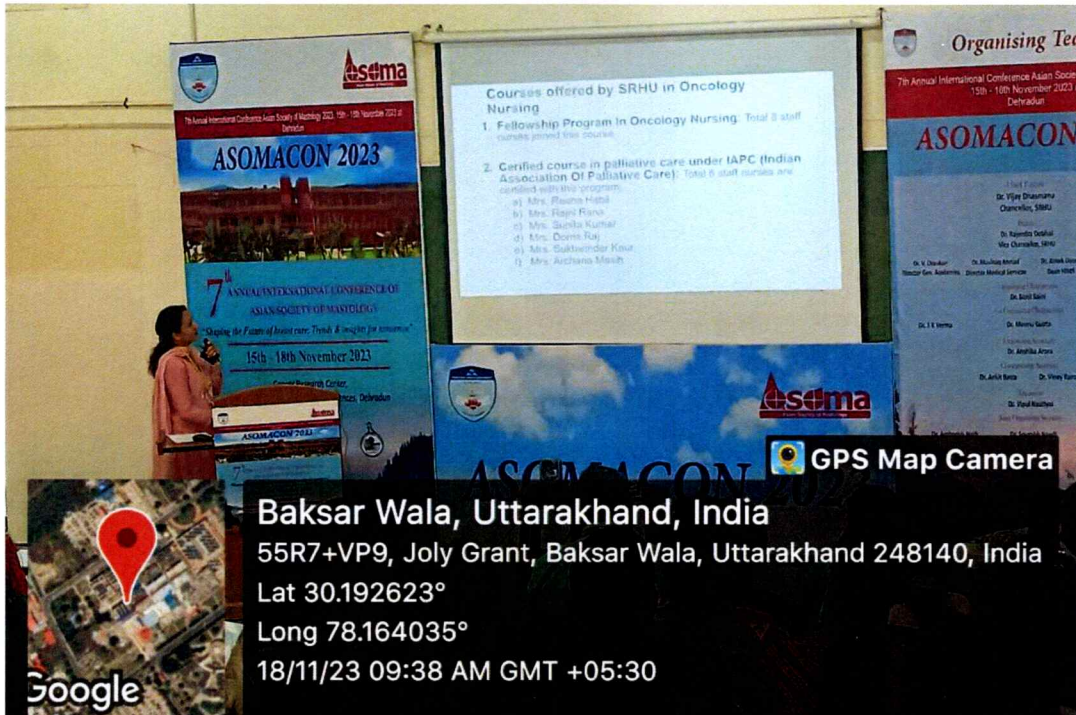




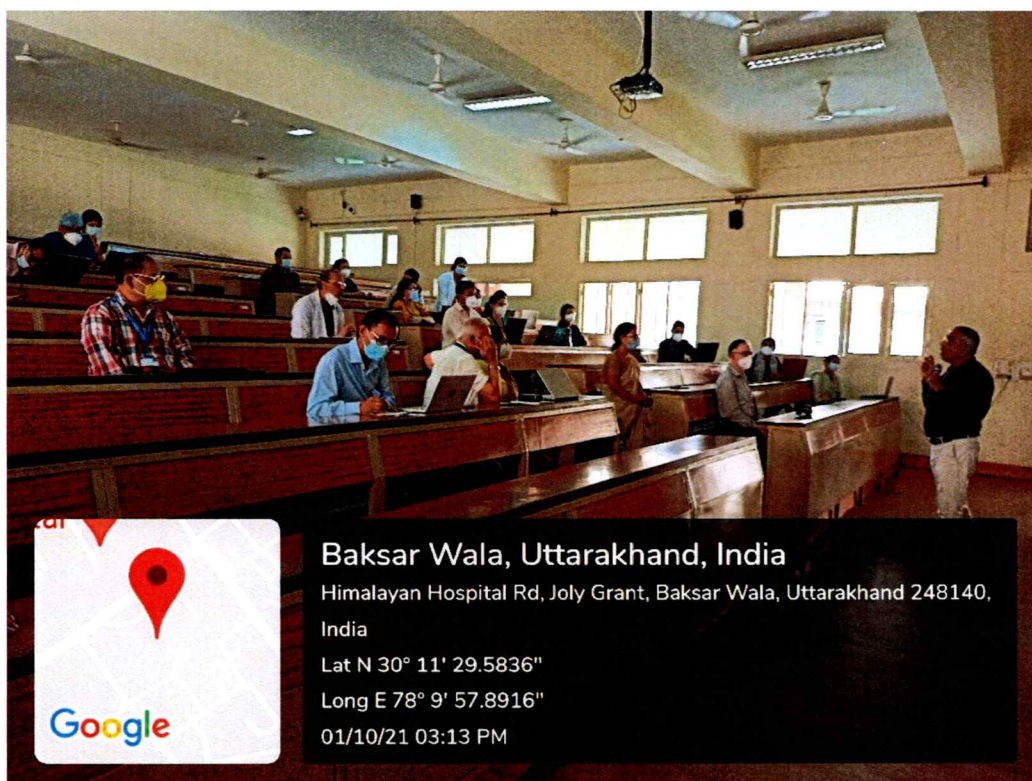
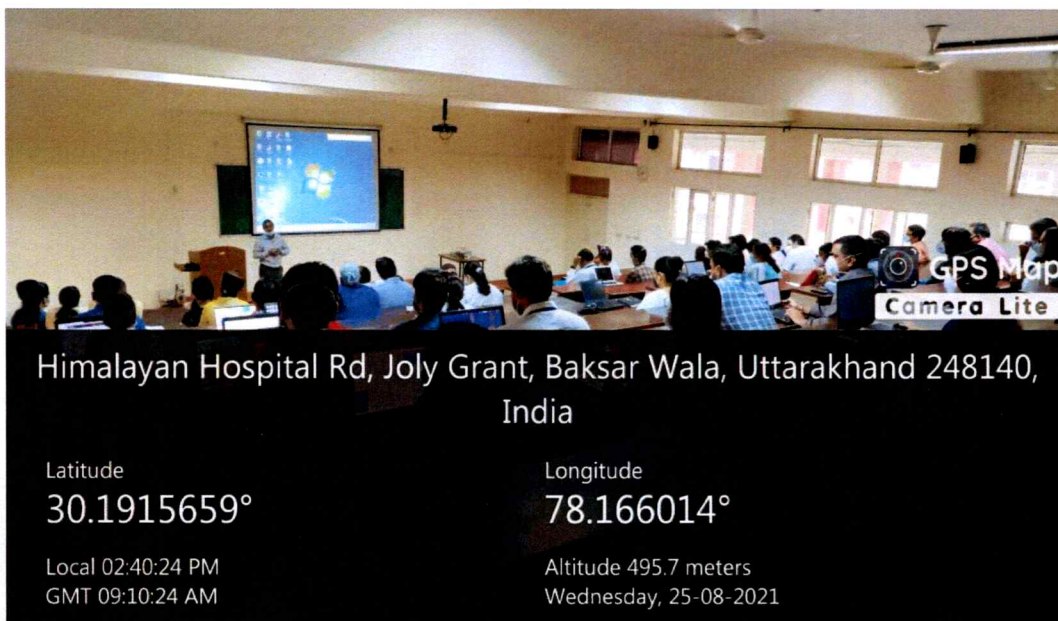

डॉ. सुनील सैनी ने कहा कि कैंसर तेजी से बढ़ रहा है। इसमें उपचार की रेडिएशन तकनीक पहले से काफी बेहतर हुई है।

मेदांता मेडिसिटी गुरुग्राम, मैक्स अस्पताल दिल्ली और देहरादून जैसे विभिन्न संस्थानों से सर्जरी, मेडिकल ऑन्कोलॉजी और रेडिएशन ऑन्कोलॉजी से विशेषज्ञ व चिकित्सकों ने प्रतिभाग किया।

कॉन्फ्रेंस में विशेष रूप से कैंसर के उपचार में सहायक स्टेरोइडिक विकिरण और रेडियोथेरेपी तकनीकों को कैसे लागू किया जाना चाहिए। इस क्षेत्र की चुनौतियों की विस्तृत जानकारी दी गई। यहां डॉ. मोनू गुप्ता, डॉ. विनय कुमार, डॉ. मुस्ताक अहमद और डॉ. एस्के वर्मा मौजूद रहे।



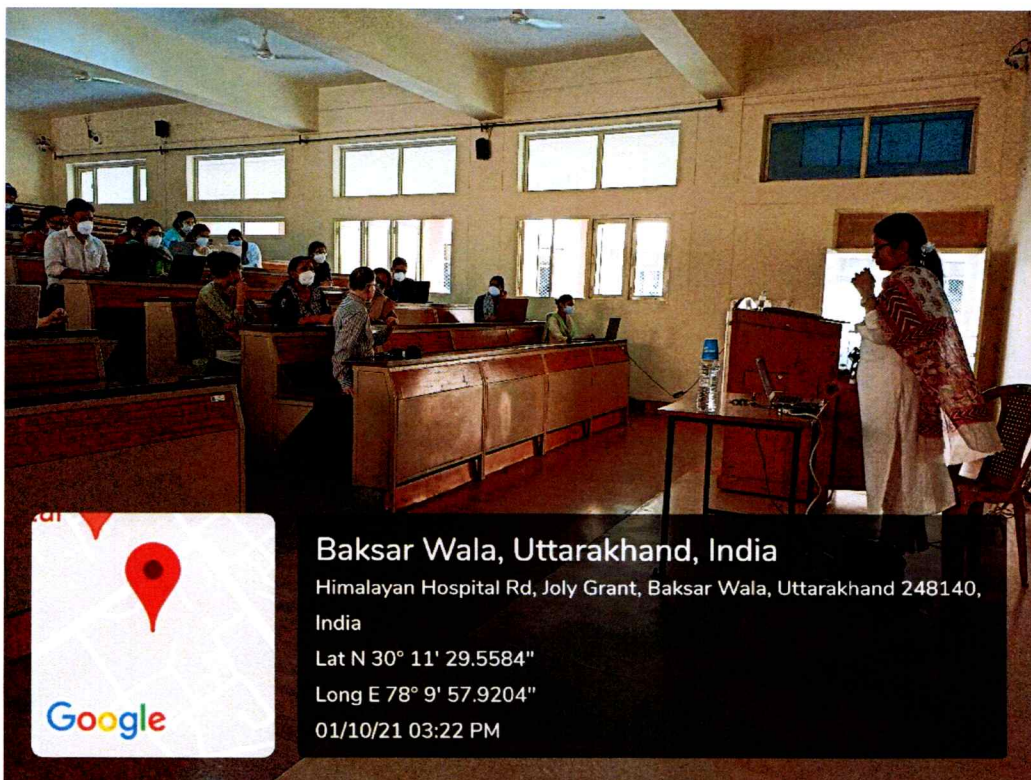
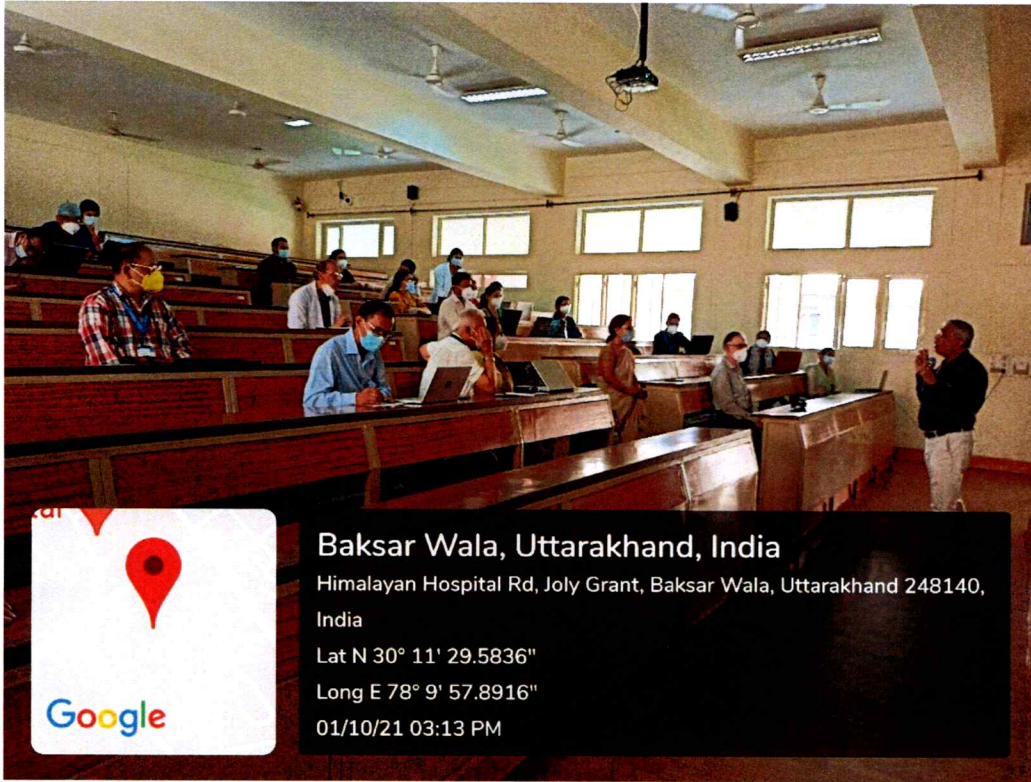

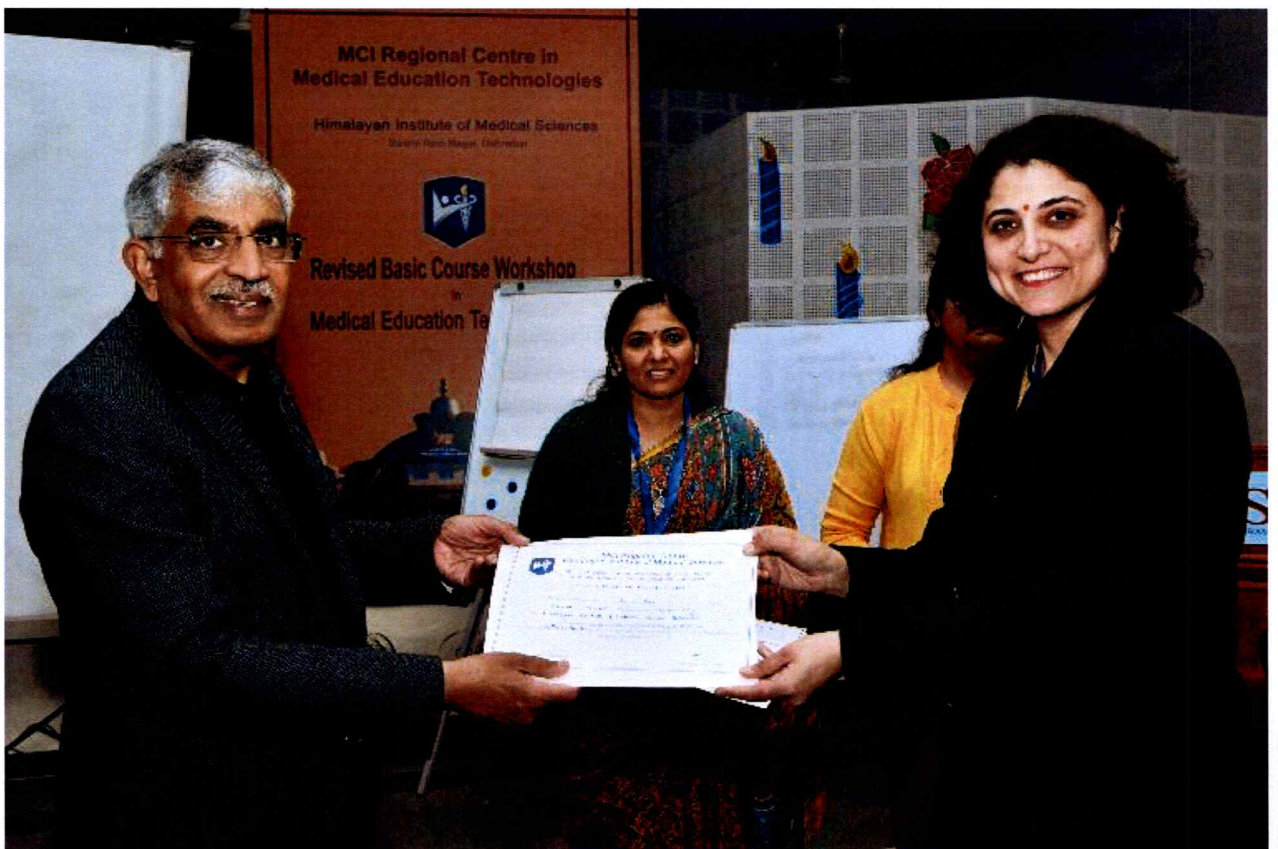

About the program

The whole world is facing unprecedented global pandemic of COVID 19 infection. The issue that is primarily medical, has turned out to have far reaching economic impact as well. While economic sectors cutting across international boundaries are impacted because of the pandemic, the services such as finance, logistics, hospitality, and even education have felt the brunt.

One of the most crucial challenges in education is in the delivery of content by the teacher, and engaging student without face to face contact. As the human-to-human transmission of the coronavirus has compelled nations to lock down and schools to close, students and teachers are hopping onto virtual platforms in order to not allow the pandemic disrupt education. The teachers are putting extra effort to engage students in classes by revamping timetables, shifting discussions online, taking feedback from parents and monitoring students constantly. While there are some who are doing the bare minimum and using WhatsApp to stay connected with students, some schools are trying out tools like Zoom, Google Suite and YouTube videos to hold live online classes besides engaging on offline mode. 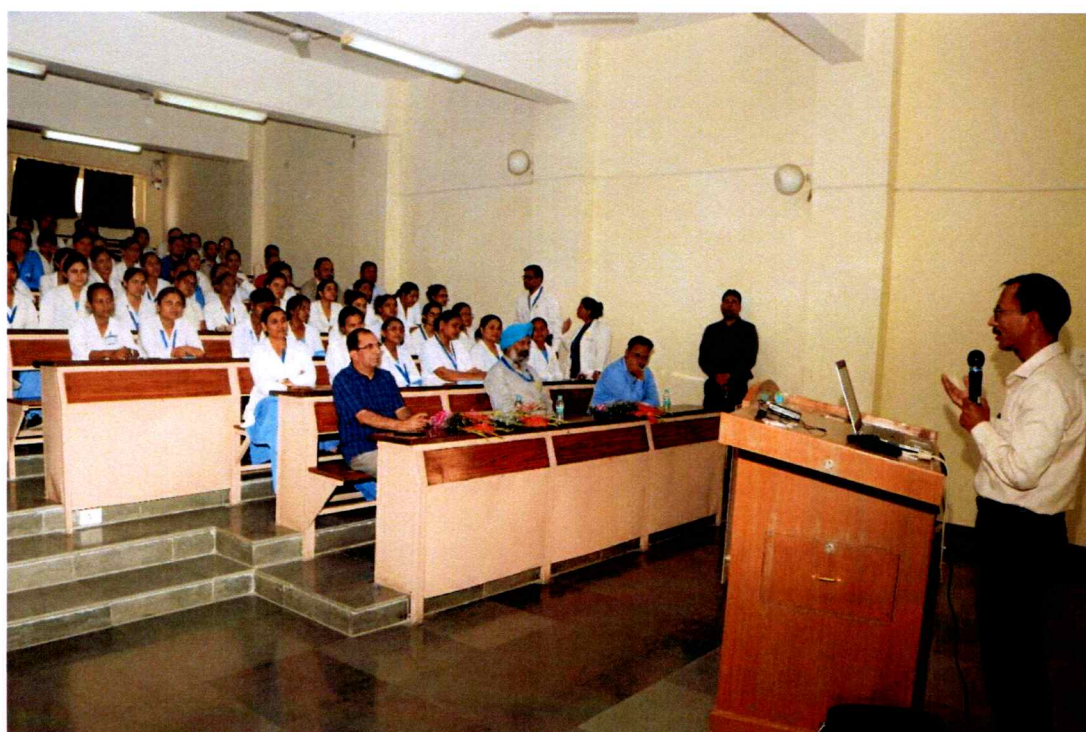

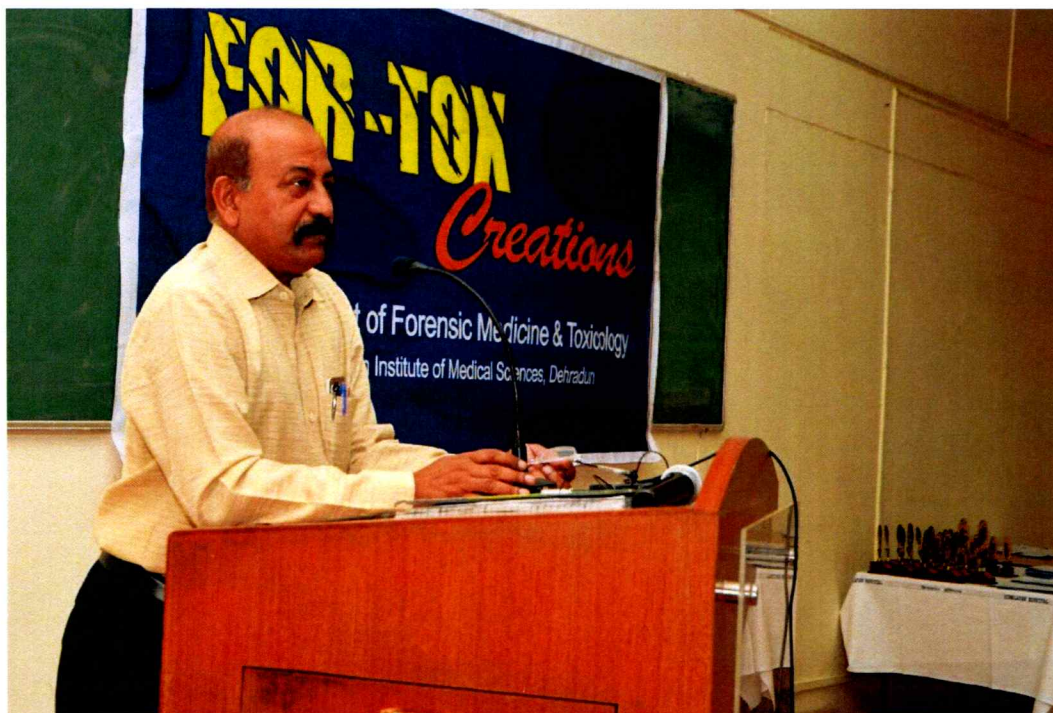
