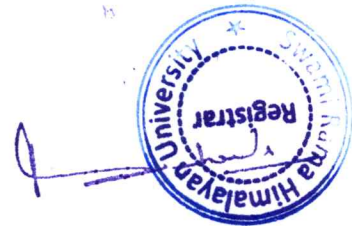

Meeting started with a prayer. The chairperson welcomed the members of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).

#### Item 4/1: To confirm the minutes of the last meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2019.

As proposed by Dr. Mushtaq Ahmad and seconded by Dr. Sunil Kumar Saini, the minutes of the last meeting were confirmed. (Annexure-1)





**Item 4/2: Considering global ongoing CORONA pandemic and its possible impact on University's quality assurance.**

Considering global ongoing CORONA pandemic it was discussed that the University must prepare itself mentally, if in case the virus also reaches India in general, and Uttarakhand in specific. It was conveyed that QA process is already in place in the hospital and the various medical teams including faculty members are on the alert.

**Item 4/3: To discuss –**

**(a) Curriculum design & development**

Dr. Vijendra Chauhan, Pro Vice Chancellor, reemphasized the concept of Programme and Course Outcomes with the members. He felt that there is a need for training the faculty members of all the academic units ensuring proper teachings & assessment with respect to the required Program and Course Outcomes and the attainment matrices therein. Accordingly the curriculum for each program must include Choice Based Credit System/Electives/Competency based Curriculum as per the requirements of the various statutory councils. The Chairman, Dr. Vijay Dhasmana, directed the Pro Vice Chancellor to organize training workshops for the faculty members on the aforesaid concepts.

**(b) Curriculum enrichment– Value Added Courses (VAC).**

To enrich the existing curriculum, increase in Value added courses in various programs was suggested by Dr. Alok Saklani. This would help in raising the standard of students above and beyond the level specified in the academic curriculum.

The list of VAC and inter disciplinary courses for the year 2020-21 received from various academic units were considered.

**Item 4/4: To apprise the members about the Academic flexibility-electives, new programs, interdisciplinary courses.**

Vice principal (UG-HIMS) brought up electives which needed to be introduced as extra academic activity for enhancing the skills of the students as was made mandatory by NMC to be part of the MBBS curriculum.

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Some new programmes were introduced by NMC which needed to be implemented in near future for the stakeholders to have a wider option to choose from and expertise to acquire for a promising future.

Some interdisciplinary courses were suggested to bring more interactions and provide flexible degree options for the students as suggested in Annexure 3B.

**Item 4/5: To discuss Government / Non-government grants for research projects**

Dr. Vijendra Chauhan, Pro Vice Chancellor, requested the principals to motivate the faculty to carry out more scientific researches in their field of interest benefiting the society which could be aided by Government & Non-government agencies. A Policy of incentive for good research work already exists with the University.

**Item 4/6: To discuss guidelines/policy for-**

- **Undertaking SWAYAM / MOOC online courses**

Dr. R.C. Ramola stated that there are several online programs on Swayam & MOOC platforms, especially for Engineering & Management students. He further suggested to have guidelines on this. The Chairman requested Dr. Alok Saklani and Dr. Vijendra Chauhan to develop written guidelines on this.

- **Incentives and Honours for the teaching faculty**

Dr. Alok Saklani brought up the issue of honouring the teaching faculty and researchers of the university who have been recognised by Government/non-Government agencies, professional bodies. He said though we have a policy for honouring the best teachers and researchers of the university since long, we need to develop a detailed SOP for the same.

- **Writing /publishing of a book**

Dr Vijendra Chauhan, Pro Vice Chancellor, highlighted the issue of having a university policy/guideline for writing or publishing a book.

- **Capability enhancement & life skills development**

Dr. Ramola emphasised that the employers today look for soft skills, communication skills and other professional skills. Therefore, new



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curriculum which is under development should incorporate the above-mentioned skills.

**Item 4/7: Any other point with the permission of the chair**

No other point came-up for discussion and the meeting concluded with Vote of Thanks to the Chair.
