11.	Dissolution	In the event of dissolution, the assets and liabilities of the Club shall be transferred to the Swami Rama Himalayan University.


5. Services Offered

- Collaborate with RDI for community sensitization in remote villages
- Create digital campaigns in Hindi/Garhwali to promote donation ethics
- Organize student-led pledge drives for organ and tissue donation
- Facilitate interactive sessions with transplant recipients and donor families
- Support Hospital Cornea Retrieval Program through student volunteering





The Blood Donation and Organ Awareness Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University on 23rd January 2024 celebrated “Prakram Diwas” to commemorate the birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Ji, one of India’s most revered freedom fighters. The event was held within the university campus to honour Netaji’s extraordinary courage, patriotism, and contribution to India’s independence movement. The celebration also served as an opportunity to raise awareness about the importance of voluntary blood donation and the need for safe blood and blood products in healthcare. Recognizing that voluntary donors form the cornerstone of blood transfusion services worldwide, the department organized a voluntary blood donation camp at the Blood Centre of Himalayan Hospital as part of the day’s activities. The camp witnessed enthusiastic participation from students, staff, and faculty, resulting in the successful collection of 43 units of whole blood.

The Blood Donation and Organ Awareness Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University observed World Blood Donor Day on 14th June 2024 with a meaningful celebratory event held at the Blood Centre premises. The celebration aimed to raise awareness about the importance of safe blood and blood products and to acknowledge the invaluable contribution of voluntary blood donors who form the foundation of blood transfusion services across the world.

The event began with the felicitation of regular voluntary whole blood and apheresis donors, followed by a brief interaction and refreshments to honor their consistent support. The World Health Organization (WHO) theme for 2024, "*Celebrating 20 years of giving: Thank you Blood Donors,*" highlighted the 20th anniversary of this global campaign and expressed gratitude toward millions of donors for their life-saving contributions. The event emphasized the significance of sharing blood as a gift of life and encouraged continued participation in voluntary blood donation drives.

The Blood Donation and Organ Awareness Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University observed World Blood Donor Day on 14th June 2023 with a meaningful and celebratory event held within the university campus. The event aimed to acknowledge and appreciate the invaluable contribution of voluntary blood donors, while simultaneously raising awareness about the importance of safe and regular blood donation in saving lives. The celebration included a felicitation ceremony honouring several regular voluntary whole blood and apheresis donors who have consistently supported the blood transfusion services. The department expressed gratitude to these donors for their life-saving contributions and emphasized the vital role that voluntary blood donation plays in sustaining healthcare systems worldwide.

The theme announced by the World Health Organization (WHO) for the year 2023 was "*Give blood, give plasma, share life, and share often. Join the effort and save lives.*" This theme highlighted the importance of sharing the gift of blood and plasma more frequently to meet the growing demand for blood components and to ensure that patients in need receive timely transfusions. The event also included a pledge ceremony, where students, staff, and faculty members reaffirmed their commitment to promoting voluntary blood donation and raising public awareness about its humanitarian and medical significance.

In commemoration of this special day, the Blood Centre at HIMS organized both in-house and external voluntary blood donation camps, including one in collaboration with the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Tehri. A total of 85 units of whole blood were collected through these initiatives, demonstrating the university community's active participation and sense of responsibility toward society.

Further extending the celebration into a week-long awareness initiative, two blood grouping camps were organized at the Himalayan College of Biosciences on 9th June 2023 and at the Himalayan College of Yoga Sciences on 13th June 2023. These camps received an enthusiastic response, with 87 potential donors registering themselves voluntarily for future blood donations. All details of the events and collected
