## REPORT

The Business Ethics Forum of Swami Rama Himalayan University organized an enriching guest lecture on the theme “*Navigating Ethical Challenges in the Workplace*” on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2024. The session aimed to familiarize first-year management and commerce students with the ethical dilemmas commonly encountered in professional environments while equipping them with essential tools for ethical decision-making. Students from MBA, BBA, and B.Com programs participated actively throughout the one-hour interactive session.

The speaker began by explaining the significance of ethics in modern organizational culture, emphasizing the value of integrity, fairness, accountability, and transparency as foundations for sustainable professional growth. Key focus areas included real-world ethical conflicts such as favouritism, data misuse, discrimination, and conflicts of interest. To help students structure their approach to ethical problem-solving, the lecture introduced decision-making frameworks such as the Four-Way Test and the principles of Utilitarian and Deontological Ethics.

Case-based examples drawn from HR, marketing, and finance roles helped students relate ethical challenges to practical scenarios. The session also featured active group discussions, where students analysed workplace dilemmas and shared their perspectives on responsible and ethical responses. The lecture encouraged students to reflect on their personal values and highlighted the importance of building an ethical foundation early in their academic and professional journey, reinforcing that ethical leadership develops through consistent everyday actions.

The event concluded with students expressing appreciation for the insightful session, noting key takeaways such as a deeper understanding of ethical complexities in the workplace, enhanced critical thinking toward moral dilemmas, and a renewed interest in exploring ethics-focused learning. The session successfully fostered awareness, curiosity, and responsible thinking among the participants, who also showed enthusiasm for similar future workshops involving practical case simulations and role-play activities.


