

The Climate Action Club, in collaboration with Hindustan Hindi Newspaper, organized the “Himalay Bachao Abhiyan” Oath Programme on 6th September 2024 at the Himalayan School of Management Studies, Swami Rama Himalayan University (SRHU). The event formed a part of the week-long Himalay Bachao Abhiyan (Save the Himalayas Campaign), conducted annually from 1st to 9th September, to coincide with the observance of Himalaya Diwas on 9th September. The campaign focuses on creating awareness and mobilizing collective action for the preservation and protection of the fragile Himalayan ecosystem.


