The Eco Club,, Swami Rama Himalayan University in collaboration with the Himalayan School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, successfully organized a Guest Lecture on “Environment Management” on 10th August 2024 at the *Himalayan School of Biosciences*, Swami Rama Himalayan University. The session was delivered by Dr. Sanjay Bhutani, *Professor (Consultant), UPES Dehradun*, and was attended by 46 students who participated enthusiastically throughout the event.

Dr. Bhutani delivered an insightful lecture emphasizing the urgent need for sustainable environmental practices in the face of global challenges such as pollution, resource depletion, and climate change. 

On 17th September 2024, the Eco Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University in collaboration with the Himalayan School of Pharmaceutical Sciences (HSPS) and the Rural Development Institute (RDI), organized a highly insightful and interactive Guest Lecture at *Swami Rama Himalayan University*. The session was designed to enhance awareness among students about pressing environmental issues and to promote active engagement in addressing ecological challenges through sustainable practices and community participation.

The event was graced by Mr. Chandi Prasad Bhatt, one of India's most respected environmentalists and a pioneer of the *Chipko Movement*, whose lifelong dedication to environmental protection and community development has inspired generations. Over the decades, Mr. Bhatt's remarkable contributions to environmental conservation have earned him numerous prestigious honours, including the Ramon Magsaysay Award for Community Leadership (1982), the Padma Bhushan (2005), the Gandhi Peace Prize (2013) presented by the President of India, the Sri Sathya Sai Award for Human Excellence in the Environment Category (2016), and the Indira Gandhi Award for National Integration (2017–2018).

During the session, Mr. Bhatt delivered an impactful address on the urgent environmental challenges confronting the Himalayan region an area known for its fragile ecosystems and critical ecological significance. He highlighted how deforestation, climate change, unregulated tourism, and resource exploitation are leading to irreversible environmental degradation, threatening biodiversity and the livelihoods of local communities.

Drawing from his vast experience in environmental activism and grassroots mobilization, Mr. Bhatt shared stories from his journey of conservation and community empowerment in the Himalayan states. He emphasized the necessity of sustainable development practices, reforestation efforts, and the promotion of community-led environmental initiatives that actively involve local populations in safeguarding their natural surroundings.

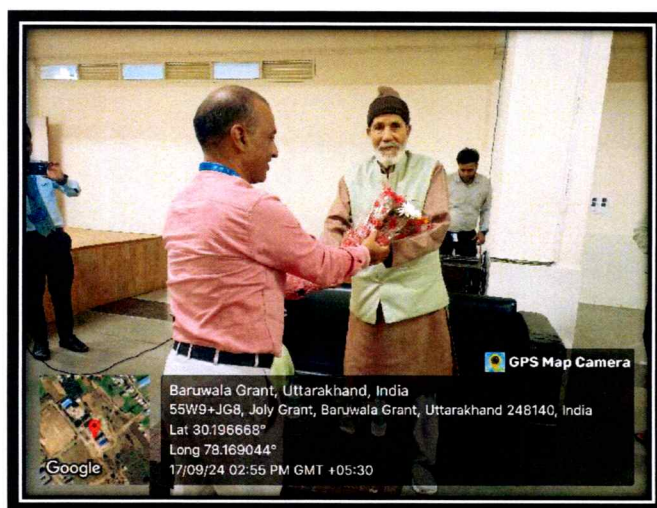

Mr. Bhatt also underscored the importance of collaboration between policymakers, scientists, educators, and communities to develop practical, long-term solutions to environmental problems. He stressed that education and youth engagement are central to building an environmentally conscious society. Encouraging the students to take small but consistent steps toward sustainability, he urged them to integrate environmental ethics into their daily lives by conserving resources, reducing waste, and spreading awareness among peers and families.


The session was deeply inspiring and thought-provoking. Students actively participated in discussions and expressed their commitment to contributing toward ecological preservation. Many reflected on how Mr. Bhatt's insights reshaped their understanding of individual responsibility in environmental protection. His message resonated strongly, reminding participants that preserving the environment is not only a collective duty but also a personal moral obligation, especially for those living in the ecologically sensitive Himalayan region.

The Guest Lecture by Mr. Chandi Prasad Bhatt served as a powerful reminder of the vital relationship between humanity and nature. It reinforced the university's ongoing efforts to integrate sustainability and environmental awareness into its educational mission, empowering students to become informed, responsible, and proactive stewards of the environment.

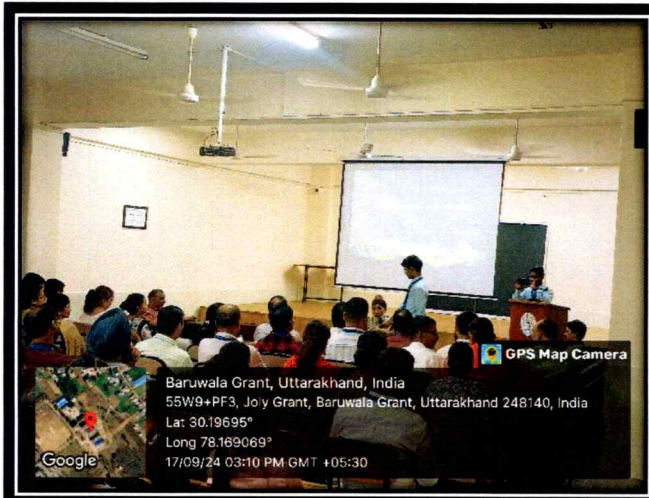


