The Gender Equality and Inclusion Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University as part of continuous efforts to promote health, dignity, and gender-sensitive education, a Menstrual Hygiene Awareness Lecture was organized on 10th August 2024 for newly admitted B.Sc. and M.Sc. female students of the Himalayan School of Biosciences, in collaboration with.

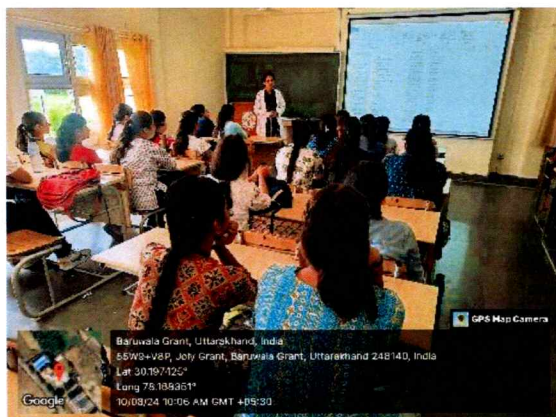
The session was led by Ms. Shama Praveen, who delivered an engaging and informative lecture aimed at empowering young women with accurate knowledge and practical guidance about menstrual health and hygiene.

The lecture covered key aspects of menstrual well-being, including the basics of the menstrual cycle, safe and hygienic practices, and the proper use and disposal of menstrual products. Ms. Praveen also discussed common health complications that may arise from poor hygiene practices and emphasized the importance of breaking taboos and dismantling stigma associated with menstruation. Participants were encouraged to act as peer educators, helping spread awareness and normalize menstrual health discussions within their communities.

An interactive discussion followed, creating an open and comfortable space where students shared questions, clarified doubts, and engaged in meaningful dialogue. The session fostered confidence and encouraged a positive, informed approach toward menstrual health.

The program proved highly impactful, as students reported increased awareness, confidence in addressing menstrual issues, and motivation to adopt and promote healthy practices. The initiative successfully reinforced SRHU's commitment to advancing gender equality, health education, and social awareness among young women.

The Gender Equality and Inclusion Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University to commemorate World Breastfeeding Week 2024, a series of impactful awareness and counselling sessions were organized from 1st to 7th August 2024 in collaboration with Departments of Paediatrics and Community Medicine, Rural Development Institute. The initiative reflected SRHU's strong commitment to gender equality, maternal health, and inclusive community engagement.

The week-long celebration included activities across both hospital and community settings, aimed at promoting the importance of breastfeeding, dispelling myths, and empowering mothers with the right knowledge and confidence.

At the HIMS Postnatal Ward, faculty members from the Department of Paediatrics Dr. Anil Rawat (HoD), Dr. Kanishka, and Dr. Radhika—led counselling sessions for new mothers. They provided practical guidance on early initiation, exclusive breastfeeding, and overcoming common challenges. The sessions also emphasized emotional support and motivation for lactating mothers.

Meanwhile, the Department of Community Medicine, in collaboration with the Gender Equality and Inclusion Club, conducted community outreach programs in Doiwala, Keshavpuri, Jhabrawala, Nagthat, and Kalsi. These included role plays, group discussions, and interactive health talks focused on the composition and benefits of breast milk, debunking myths such as “insufficient milk,” correct breastfeeding techniques, and the importance of frequent feeding. Demonstrations were also held on expressing breast milk, particularly to assist working mothers in maintaining breastfeeding practices.

The Rural Development Institute (RDI) extended the initiative through community sensitisation drives, engaging mothers and families in awareness sessions on the importance of colostrum, the long-term health benefits of breastfeeding, and correct positioning and latching techniques. The participation of Community Health Officers (CHOs), ASHAs, and Anganwadi workers at PHC Kalsi enhanced the reach and impact of these programs.

The multi-sectoral collaboration successfully advanced SRHU's mission to promote gender-sensitive health practices, inclusive maternal care, and community empowerment. The initiative not only celebrated the essence of World Breastfeeding Week but also fostered sustainable behavioral change within the communities.

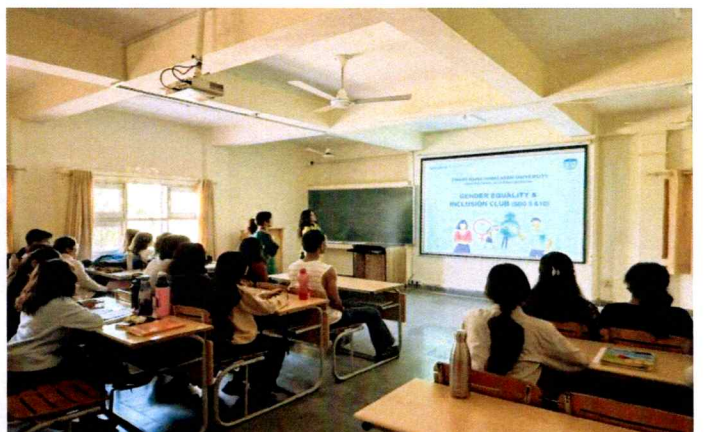
