The Local Community Impact Club under the SDG Champions Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University, in collaboration with the Department of Himalayan School of Science and Technology (HSST) organized a 36-hour internal hackathon titled "*Tech Forge 2024*" from 9th to 10th September 2024. 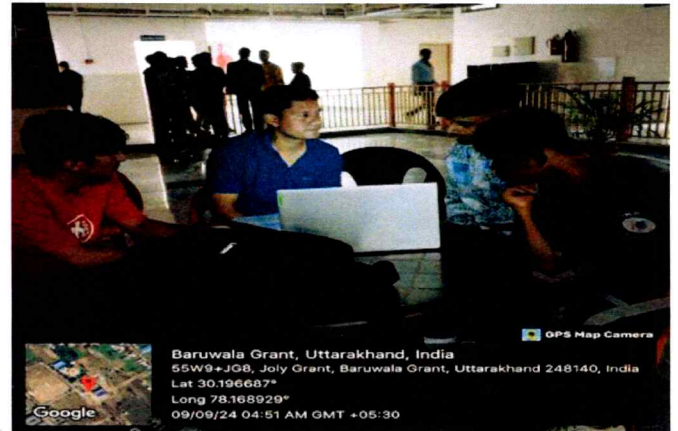
