The Pharmaceutical Innovation Club of *Swami Rama Himalayan University* organized a Hands-on Training Session on ChemDraw Software on 14th May 2024. The session aimed to enhance the practical understanding and technical skills of students in using ChemDraw, a globally recognized chemical drawing software widely employed by chemists, researchers, educators, and students for visualizing and analysing molecular structures and chemical reactions.

The training program was designed to familiarize participants with the features, tools, and practical applications of ChemDraw in scientific research and academic documentation. The session emphasized how the software supports accurate chemical representation, facilitates research communication, and improves efficiency in designing chemical structures for publications and presentations.

Adopting a participatory and interactive learning approach, the training blended brief theoretical discussions with live demonstrations and practical exercises. Participants were guided through each step of using ChemDraw—from drawing basic molecular structures to editing complex compounds and applying correct chemical nomenclature. The trainer, Mr. Rahul Pandey, ensured active engagement by encouraging questions, discussions, and collaborative problem-solving throughout the session. Students practiced using various ChemDraw tools to gain familiarity with its interface and explored its applications in molecular visualization, data annotation, and reaction mechanism illustration.

The session proved to be highly productive and insightful for the participants. They reported improved proficiency in drawing and editing chemical structures, enhanced understanding of chemical nomenclature and representation, and better visualization of complex molecular interactions. Students also recognized the relevance of ChemDraw in research documentation, report preparation, and scientific presentations, making the training directly applicable to their academic and professional growth.

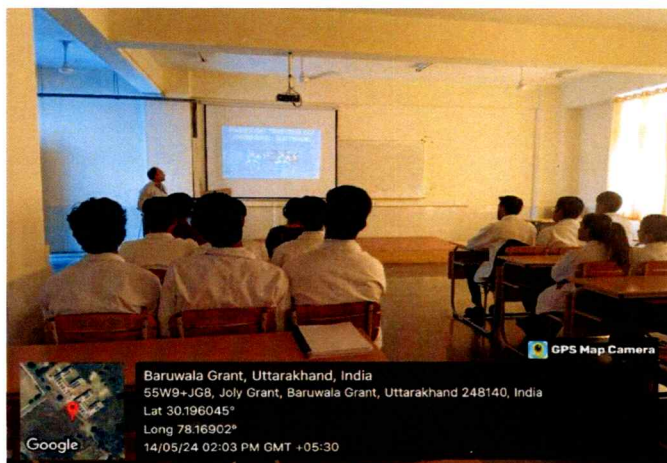
