The Research Club, Swami Rama Himalayan University, celebrated World AMR Awareness Week (WAAW) 2024 on 19th November at the University Campus. The event witnessed the participation of more than 200 attendees, including doctors, faculty members, undergraduate and postgraduate students, and research scholars. World AMR Awareness Week, observed globally from 18–24 November every year, aims to raise awareness and understanding of antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and promote responsible practices among One Health stakeholders to curb the emergence and spread of drug-resistant infections. The program was organized in the fond memory of Late Dr. Manju Sharma, Padma Bhushan, Chairman of NASI and Chairperson of the Research Advisory Committee, SRHU. Dr. Rajendra Dobhal, Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University, reflected upon her remarkable contributions to science and technology.

The theme for WAAW 2024, “Educate. Advocate. Act now.”, was selected through a global online survey involving experts from human, animal, plant, and environmental health sectors, receiving nearly 200 responses worldwide.

The distinguished guest speaker, Prof. Ranjana Pathania, Department of Biosciences and Bioengineering, IIT Roorkee, emphasized the seriousness of AMR and highlighted the urgent need for new antibacterial drug discovery. She presented her laboratory's research focused on combating resistance in six major ESKAPE pathogens. Prof. Urmila Bajpai, Department of Biomedical Sciences, Acharya Narendra Dev College, University of Delhi, delivered an insightful talk on the application of phage therapy as both an adjunct and a standalone approach to address AMR. She emphasized the pivotal role that medical college-cum-hospital systems can play in translating phage research from the laboratory to real-world therapeutic products.

The event concluded with a formal vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Bindu Dey, Director, Research, SRHU. The active involvement of the Research Club added significant value to the event by fostering scientific dialogue and strengthening the university's commitment toward AMR awareness, research advancement, and community engagement.
