On December 28, 2024, the Sustainable Agriculture & Food Security Club of Swami Rama Himalayan University (SRHU), in collaboration with RDI-HIHT and the District Health Authorities, organized Tuberculosis (TB) Screening and Nutrition Support Camps at CHC Bahadrabad and CHC Raipur, Dehradun. The activity was conducted under the Nikshay Mitra Campaign, supporting the national mission to eliminate tuberculosis through early detection, effective treatment, and nutritional assistance. The initiative included on-site TB screening to identify suspected cases, counseling sessions for patients and their families, and the distribution of nutrition kits to TB patients to support their recovery and strengthen treatment adherence. The awareness sessions emphasized the importance of nutrition, regular medication, and preventive measures to manage and overcome the disease.

The collaborative effort successfully enhanced community participation, improved TB detection rates, and provided essential nutritional and psychological support to affected individuals. The program reflected SRHU's ongoing commitment to improving community health and fostering partnerships for effective healthcare delivery.
