
4. Terms and Conditions

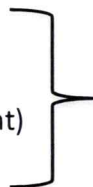

The Tech & Innovation in Healthcare Club, SST, is pleased to report the successful participation of students from the School of Science & Technology in an Online Seminar on Artificial Intelligence in Neonatology, conducted on 6th February 2025. The session was organized by the Department of Neonatology and featured distinguished speakers including Dr. Saikat Patra, Dr. Chandini, and Prof. (Dr.) Ashok Kumar Deorari, all of whom are experts in neonatal care and digital health innovations.


