

Anti Ragging Guidelines

What Constitutes Ragging

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of following acts:

- any conduct by any student or students whether by words, spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of causing, creating or maintaining mental harassment or an other student.
- Indulging in, inciting, inducing, forcing, pressuring any student or students which causes or is likely to cause harassment, hurt, physical, psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension amongst students in any manner.
- causing any student to do any act which such student whilst active ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or creating mental harassment or physical, psychological harm or adversely affect the physical or psyche of such brother or any other student.
- any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or distorts the regular academic activity of any other student or student.
- registering the services of a brother or any other student for financial or other benefits or for the benefit of any other student or students.
- any act of financial or other benefit or benefit to one student or students by any other student.
- any act of physical abuse including all varieties of sexual assault, corporal punishment, mental harassment, and cruel acts, tortures, causing body harm or any other damage to the person.
- any act or abetment of Captain, Wards, Ranks, post, public posts which would also include deriving personal pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the conduct to which the victim is subjected.
- any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a brother or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any brother or any other student.

Punishable Ingredients of Ragging

Ragging is a punishable offence under the Indian penal laws with appropriate penal provisions related to one or more of the following, namely:

- Abetment to ragging
- Obstructive conspiracy to ragging
- Unlawful assembly while ragging
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Using to body causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Wrongful confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offence or criminal offence
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences
- Threat to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- Physical or psychological humiliation
- All other offences falling from the definition of "Ragging"

Anybody found to be involved in ragging shall be handed over to police.

As per the Hon'ble Supreme Court's directive, ragging in any form is a **Virtual, Physical, Psychological or completely **based in Educational Institutions**.**

Ragging is a **criminal and non-criminal** offence. Any person who indulges in or abets ragging whether actively or passively or being a party to the conduct to which the ragging has an intention, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 10 years. All students are warned to desist from indulging in any kind of ragging.

Definition of Ragging

"Any act of, or attempt to, or abetment of, (including incitement and incitation) targeted or directed towards any member of the institution on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including Transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, education, social status, linguistic identity, place of birth, place or economic background."

All faculty, staff and students are requested to report any incidence of ragging/ harassment immediately to following officials for assistance.
