The Chair commenced the meeting by extending a warm welcome to all members and underscoring the critical importance of ensuring strict enforcement and adherence to the university's anti-ragging policies, in full compliance with established regulations.

#### **1. Anti-Ragging Measures and Sub-Committee Functions**

The Chair provided a comprehensive overview of the structure and operational functions of the various sub-committees established to prevent and combat ragging on campus. It was reiterated that these sub-committees play a pivotal role in maintaining a ragging-free environment. Members were apprised of the anti-ragging measures currently in place, including the submission of affidavits by students and their parents, affirming their commitment to upholding the university's anti-ragging policy. Similarly, commitments have been secured from hostel staff, security personnel, mess workers, and other campus employees to ensure their active participation in preventing ragging incidents. Communication has been sent to all parents, urging them to counsel their children against engaging in ragging activities. Furthermore, members were encouraged to provide moral support and guidance to newly admitted students to facilitate their smooth transition. As part of the awareness initiatives, a UGC-approved video documentary on ragging has been screened, and UGC posters—detailing the definition of ragging, associated punishments, and important contact information—have been prominently displayed across the campus. It was unanimously agreed that a zero-tolerance stance towards ragging would be strictly enforced, and members reaffirmed their collective commitment to upholding this mandate.

#### **2. Orientation Sessions and Senior-Student Interaction**

The discussion then turned to the importance of organizing structured orientation sessions designed to foster healthy introductions and social interactions between new students and their seniors. Members emphasized that these sessions should be scheduled promptly within each academic department. To ensure decorum and provide oversight, these sessions will be conducted in the presence of at least two faculty members. The Chair further suggested that members of the Anti-Ragging Cell and Monitoring Committee participate in informal social gatherings with the newly admitted students, including attending meals at the student mess, to foster a sense of community and provide reassurance to first-year students.

#### **3. Student Engagement through Cultural and Extracurricular Activities**

Recognizing the value of keeping new students constructively engaged, members deliberated on the need to incorporate evening activities, such as cultural programs, sports events, and literary competitions. These activities would serve the dual purpose of integrating students into campus life and keeping them occupied in productive pursuits. The relevant committees will be notified to ensure the timely organization and implementation of these activities.

#### **4. Collaborative Efforts to Achieve a Ragging-Free Campus**

The committee engaged in an open discussion regarding the collective responsibility of maintaining a ragging-free campus. It was agreed that continuous feedback from both students and parents is essential to refining and enhancing the effectiveness of anti-ragging initiatives. Moreover, it was proposed that an anonymous feedback mechanism be introduced to encourage students to report any concerns without fear of reprisal. Additional measures, such as peer mentoring programs and faculty-student interaction forums, were also considered as potential avenues to promote a more inclusive and

supportive campus environment.

The meeting concluded with a formal vote of thanks to the Chair, acknowledging their leadership and dedication to creating a safe and welcoming environment for all students.
