- Raise awareness about organ and tissue donation, including eye and kidney donation.
- Support SRHU's community health initiatives through student-led drives and campaigns.
- Collaborate with HIHT's Blood Centre, Eye Bank, Nephrology and Anatomy department for experiential learning.
- Promote ethical, informed decision-making around donation and end-of-life care.


4. Terms and Conditions

- Collaborate with RDI for community sensitization in remote villages
- Create digital campaigns in Hindi/Garhwali to promote donation ethics
- Organize student-led pledge drives for organ and tissue donation
- Facilitate interactive sessions with transplant recipients and donor families
- Support Hospital Cornea Retrieval Program through student volunteering



23rd January 2024: Celebratory Event

Venue- Department of Immunohematology & Blood Transfusion at HIMS

On **January 23, 2024**, the Blood Donation & Organ Awareness Club in collaboration with Department of Immunohematology & Blood Transfusion at HIMS, under the aegis of the Swami Rama Himalayan University, celebrated “**Prakram Diwas**” to honour the birthday of the Indian freedom fighter, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Ji. The event was held on our university campus and aimed to raise awareness about the importance of safe blood and blood products. As part of the event, we organized a voluntary blood donation camp at the blood centre of Himalayan Hospital, where we collected **43 whole blood units**. The main objective of the event was to recognize Netaji's pivotal role in the Indian Independence Movement and pay tribute to him on this day celebrated as the “Day of Valour”. We also aimed to emphasize the significance of voluntary blood donors who are considered the cornerstone for blood transfusion services worldwide. Activity 02- Celebratory Event: “World Blood Donor Day” 14th June 2024

Venue- Department of Immunohematology & Blood Transfusion at HIMS



The Blood Donation & Organ Awareness Club in collaboration with Department of Immunohematology and Blood Transfusion, HIMS, SRHU observed the World Blood Donor's Day on 14th June 2024 in a celebratory event held within our blood center premises. The celebratory event comprised felicitating a few voluntary regular whole blood and apheresis donors, followed by refreshments. This event was celebrated to raise awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products and acknowledge the importance of blood donors as “the cornerstone for blood transfusion services globally”. The world health organization theme for this year was “Celebrating 20 years of giving: Thank you Blood Donors” which primarily aimed to thank the donors for their precious gift of life and highlight the dimension of sharing it to the recipients. A pledge to raise more awareness regarding the importance of voluntary blood donation was taken on the said date.

The event was graced by HIMS faculty and a few postgraduate and undergraduate students who donated their whole blood enthusiastically. A handful of MBBS students also did a small role-play on the importance of blood donation. On this auspicious day, the Blood Centre also organized an in-house as well as an outside voluntary blood donation camp (in association with the Amar Ujala Foundation, Tehri Garhwal) in which cumulatively 105 units of whole blood units were collected. Additionally, in the spirit of celebrating the event for a week, two blood grouping camps were also organized in the Himalayan College of Yoga Sciences and Physiotherapy on 07/06/2024 and 12/06/2024 respectively. In both these grouping camps, 115 proposed donors registered their names willingly, for future donations.


स्वैच्छिक रक्तदान शिविर में 100 युनिट रक्त एकत्रित



14th June 2025: Celebratory Event

The Blood Donation & Organ Awareness Club in collaboration with Department of Immunohematology & Blood Transfusion, HIMS, SRHU observed the World Blood Donor Day on 14th June 2025 with a meaningful celebratory program aimed at raising awareness about the importance of voluntary blood donation/s. This event was celebrated to raise awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products and acknowledge the importance of blood donors. This year, the campaign slogan was - "Give blood, give hope: together we save lives" which primarily aimed to thank the donors for their precious gift of hope and life highlighting the dimension of coming together as a community to save lives through selfless blood donations. The event began with a ceremonial lamp lighting and was graced by the Chief Guest, Dr. Hem Chandra Pandey, Director – Hospital Services, Himalayan Hospital, SRHU. The celebratory event comprised felicitating a few voluntary regular whole blood donors. A pledge to raise more awareness regarding the importance of voluntary blood donation was also facilitated on the same day. 1) Voluntary Blood Donation Camp:

2. Voluntary Blood Grouping and Haemoglobin Camp:

As part of the observance, a Blood Group and haemoglobin testing Camp was conducted for nursing students from the Himalayan College of Nursing, SRHU. In this camp, 115 proposed donors registered their names willingly, for future donations. Those with appropriate hemoglobin levels participated in the blood donation drive, while students found to have low hemoglobin levels were guided on improving iron intake through diet and were advised to undergo a re-test after three months.
