Name of Activity: Young Climate Champion Webinar-2025

Date: 3rd March 2025

Summary:

The Climate Action Club in collaboration with Himalayan College of Nursing organized a webinar session focused on the Young Climate Champion Award, where the discussion centered around various initiatives and actions aimed at combating climate change. One of the key topics discussed was Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment), which emphasizes driving behavioral change to promote sustainable living. This includes simple actions such as turning off lights and fans when not in use, using reusable shopping bags, and adopting indoor plants. Another important theme was the Circular Economy and Waste Management, highlighting innovative ideas like using recycled materials, such as rice husk for making shoe laces, as well as promoting the development of eco-friendly alternatives that reduce waste and encourage recycling.

The session also covered Climate Action and Resilience, encouraging creative approaches to raise awareness, such as modifying rhymes like “Johny Johny, Yes Papa” to include environmental messages, e.g., “Using plastic? No papa. Reuse and recycle? Yes papa!” Additionally, participants were encouraged to engage in activities that foster a personal connection with nature, such as naming plants, and raising awareness about the importance of biodiversity through workshops, campaigns, and interactive sessions. In terms of Sustainable Urban Development, the session discussed measures to minimize plastic use in hospitals by switching to biodegradable or reusable materials, such as syringes, gloves, and packaging.

Another major topic was Water Conservation and Management, where the focus was on initiatives like encouraging restaurants to serve smaller portions of water and to promote refills, helping to conserve water. The session emphasized that projects should be replicable across various regions and adaptable to different contexts, with a focus on creating long-term environmental impact. Participants could choose to work individually or in teams of five and were encouraged to select a mentor or guide for support and guidance in refining their ideas

for better implementation. The overall aim of the session was to inspire participants to engage in sustainable practices that have a lasting positive effect on the environment.

The session was facilitated by Mr. John Davidson (Assistant Professor, Community Health Department), Mrs. Heena Negi (Nursing Tutor, Mental Health Nursing Department), Mr. Ankit Singh (Nursing Tutor, Adult Health Nursing Department).
