1.	<b>Quorum</b>	50% of the total members
2.	<b>Tenure of the Club</b>	Perpetual
3.	<b>Tenure of the Chairperson</b>	3 years
4.	<b>Tenure of the Members</b>	2-3 years
5.	<b>Frequency of Meetings</b>	<i>Preferably once per quarter.</i>
6.	<b>Meeting Notice and Agenda</b>	The member secretary with prior approval of Chairperson shall circulate the Meeting Notice and Agenda to all the members at least seven (7) working days prior to date of the meeting.
7.	<b>Minutes of the Meeting</b>	The Secretary records the minutes, which are signed by the Chairperson and Secretary. A signed copy is forwarded to members within three (3) working days of the meeting.
8.	<b>Duties and function</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Organize Mission LiFE-themed campaigns and pledge drives across campus</li> <li>b) Conduct green audits and eco-behavior assessments in hostels, labs, and admin blocks</li> <li>c) Collaborate with SRHU's SDG Cell, RDI, and NSS for village-level IEC activities</li> <li>d) Document and disseminate SRHU's best practices through posters, videos, and replication kits</li> <li>e) Mobilize students and staff to participate in national observances like World Environment Day and Mission LiFE Month</li> </ul>

9.	<b>Funding and Resources</b>	a. Institutional budget allocation b. Donations and sponsorships
10.	<b>Amendments</b>	Any amendment to this club must be proposed in writing and approved by a two-thirds majority of the Club Committee.
11.	<b>Dissolution</b>	In the event of dissolution, the assets and liabilities of the Club shall be transferred to the Swami Rama Himalayan University.
