
- Health Literacy Workshops on NCDs, lifestyle diseases, and campus nutrition


Subject: Free ENT Health Camp at Shyampur, Rishikesh (Under SDG 3 Initiative)

Activity Report (Aligned with SDG 3 – Good Health and Well-being):

In alignment with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 3, which emphasizes access to quality healthcare for all, a Free ENT Health Camp was organized on 14th December 2024 at Shyampur, Rishikesh, District-Dehradun. The camp aimed to ensure equitable healthcare services, especially for underserved populations in rural areas. A total of 38 beneficiaries were examined by a specialized team of doctors and staff from the Department of Community Medicine and Department of ENT, Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences (HIMS), Jollygrant. The camp focused on the early detection, consultation, and referral of ailments related to Ear, Nose, and Throat (ENT).

Patients who required advanced ENT-related medical or surgical intervention were referred to the base hospital for further treatment. Others were given on-site consultation, medication, and lifestyle guidance. The initiative contributed significantly to enhancing access to essential healthcare services in remote areas, thereby supporting the national commitment to SDG 3.

Activity Report (Aligned with SDG 3 – Good Health and Well-being):

On 29th August 2024, a multi-specialty *Ayushman Arogya Shivir* was organized at CHC Narsan, Haridwar by the Health & Well Being Club in collaboration with Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Swami Rama Himalayan University, National Health Mission (NHM), Uttarakhand and the Chief Medical Officer, Haridwar and with specialists from various departments of HIMS namely- Community Medicine, General Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Pediatrics, Orthopaedics, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, and Dentistry. The camp focused on providing health check-ups, along with preventive care and health education, ensuring local residents received necessary medical attention without having to travel to distant healthcare facilities. Patients needing tertiary level of healthcare were referred to Civil Hospital, Roorkee and Himalayan Hospital, SRHU.. This initiative was taken in line with Sustainable Development Goal 3 (SDG 3) to ensure equitable access to healthcare and promote well-being.

Objectives of the Camp

1. Deliver specialist consultations to underserved populations.
2. Conduct diagnostic screening for early disease detection.
3. Raise awareness on preventive healthcare.
4. Refer critical patients to tertiary healthcare facilities.

Key Services Provided

1. Over 250 multi-specialty consultations.
2. Diagnostic tests including BP, hemoglobin, and blood sugar.
3. Health awareness talks on maternal care, child nutrition, and mental health.
4. Referrals to Civil Hospital Roorkee and Himalayan Hospital SRHU for advanced care.
