#### 1. Overview

The Department of Ophthalmology, HIMS, SRHU conducted multiple **Healthy Vision Campaigns** at Bhogpur, District Bijnor during June 2024 to March 2025.

These activities aimed to promote eye health, identify early visual problems, and provide basic screening services to the local community. Students actively participated to gain real-world community clinical exposure.

#### 3. Objectives

- To promote awareness on eye health and preventive ophthalmic care.
- To screen the community for refractive errors and common eye diseases.
- To educate individuals on eye hygiene and safe practices.
- To develop student competencies in conducting community-based vision screening.

#### 4. Activities Conducted

- Vision screening using standard Snellen charts.
- Basic examination for refractive errors and visible ocular abnormalities.
- Counseling on eye care, protective habits, and early detection.
- Guidance on follow-up and referral for those requiring further evaluation at Himalayan Hospital.

#### 5. Student Participation

Two students participated in each campaign. They assisted in:

- Registration of community members
- Visual acuity testing
- Documentation of findings
- Community education activities

Their involvement strengthened their understanding of community ophthalmology and patient interaction.

## **6. Outcomes**

- Benefited residents of Bhogpur by providing free eye screening and awareness.
- Early identification of refractive errors and other ocular complaints.
- Improved awareness regarding preventive eye health practices.
- Enhanced practical skills and confidence among participating students.
