1. Introduction

The Department of Ophthalmology, Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences (HIMS), SRHU, conducted the *Bright Vision Initiative* across multiple locations in **Saharanpur district**, including Deoband, Dushli, and Dhourala. The initiative focused on improving eye health awareness, identifying vision-related issues, and providing screening services to rural and semi-urban communities.

The camps aimed to bridge the gap between underserved populations and accessible eye healthcare, ensuring early detection and timely referrals.

2. Objectives of the Initiative

- To provide free eye screening services to the community
- To detect refractive errors, cataract, and other ocular conditions
- To promote awareness about preventive eye care and hygiene
- To guide and refer patients requiring further evaluation
- To provide experiential learning opportunities for participating students

3. Summary of Activities

A total of **4 Bright Vision Initiative camps** were conducted in Saharanpur District during **2024–2025**, with **2 student participants** at each location.

- Early identification of refractive and cataract cases
- Enhanced access to eye screening services in rural areas
- Strengthened community engagement


