

Time: 9:00 am to 3:00 pm

Activity details: A health camp was held at the "Himalayan Sanjeevani Clinic-Telemedicine Centre, Toli Village, Pauri" on November 10th, 2024, from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. The purpose of the camp was to screen patients for non-communicable diseases (NCDs), offer free medical exams and medication to patients, hold awareness sessions, and provide MBBS interns and MSc. Epidemiology students with practical experience in planning and running a health camp. Patient registration, vital sign monitoring, anthropometry, professional consultation, dental screening and medication distribution made up the campsite's patient flow. Every patient received all services at no cost to them. Patients who lived far out in the village received free round-trip transportation in the university vehicle.
