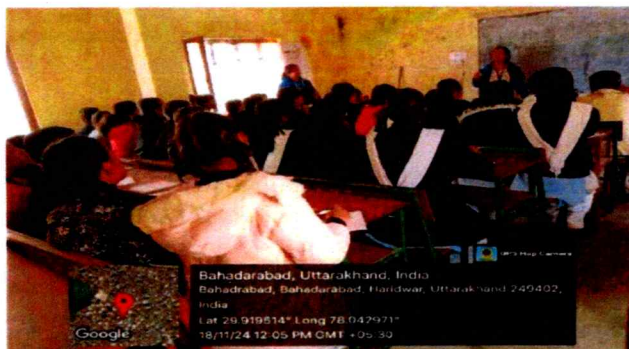

Activity Detail – Rashtriya Kishor Swasthya Karyakram (RKSK) is a national adolescent health program in India that aims to improve the health and well-being of adolescents aged 10-19 years. The program has six components which are Nutrition, Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH), Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs), Substance Misuse, Mental Health, and Injuries and Violence, including Gender-Based Violence (GBV). A two-day training session was conducted for the selected School Health & Hygiene Club members of Arya Kanya Inter College which was delivered on the three components of RKSK through a combination of lectures, case studies, and role-playing exercises including fill up of Pre-questionnaire, growth monitoring and information taken through google questionnaire. Personal Hygiene Kit was also provided to the School Principal for the students.
