




The Chairperson called a meeting on 07/01/25 at 11:30 am.

1. **Review of Existing Curriculum:** A detailed review was conducted across B.Sc. Nursing, Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing, and M.Sc. Nursing programs in accordance with the Indian Nursing Council (INC) guidelines.
2. **Mapping of Program Outcomes (POs), Course Outcomes (COs) & Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs):** The draft of the PO-CO matrix for all nursing programs was reviewed, and a minimum threshold of 60% attainment was set for each Course Outcome (CO). Emphasis was placed on aligning the curriculum with competencies and principles of outcome-based education (OBE).

3. **Curriculum Feedback Review:** Curriculum feedback had already been collected from students, faculty, alumni, and clinical stakeholders, and the Action Taken Report (ATR) was presented and reviewed in the previous meeting.
4. **Interdisciplinary Courses:** The list of interdisciplinary courses for all nursing programs was reviewed and integrated into the curriculum where applicable. (List Enclosed).
5. **Cross Cutting Issues:** The committee members discussed and incorporated cross-cutting issues within the nursing curriculum, ensuring their relevance and alignment with current healthcare and societal needs. (List of Cross Cutting Issues Enclosed).
6. **Mapping of Sustainable Goal Development:** The curriculum content was reviewed to ensure alignment with key SDGs and the committee discussed their effective integration into the nursing curriculum. (List of Mapping Enclosed).
7. **Examination and Evaluation Reforms:** Current evaluation practices OSCE/OSPE and continuous evaluation assessment were discussed and reviewed.
