**Agenda Items**

1. *Review of Existing Curriculum* – BBA, BCom, and MBA Programs in light of UGC, NEP, and NCrf 2023 guidelines.
2. *Mapping of Program Outcomes (POs), Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), and Course Outcomes (COs)* – Review of alignment and setting threshold levels.
3. *Feedback Review* – Discussion on stakeholder feedback and Action Taken Report (ATR).
4. *Mapping of Interdisciplinary Courses* – Integration across programs and relevance to current academic landscape.
5. *Cross-Cutting Issues* – Incorporation of ethics, gender, environment, and human values in curriculum.
6. *Mapping with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)* – Presentation of SDG alignment strategy across SMS curriculum.
7. *Examination and Evaluation Reforms* – Strengthening of continuous internal assessment.


**Discussion and Resolution**

1. The Committee thoroughly reviewed the current curriculum structure of BBA, BCom, and MBA programs. It was resolved to initiate necessary revisions to align with UGC regulations,




NEP 2020 mandates, and the NCrf 2023 framework to enhance academic relevance and employability.

2. The Committee examined the existing outcome mapping structure. It was resolved that all courses must demonstrate at least 60% alignment between Course Outcomes (COs) and the relevant Program Outcomes (POs) and Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), and periodic reviews shall be conducted for quality assurance.
3. Feedback collected from students, alumni, faculty, and industry stakeholders was presented along with the Action Taken Report (ATR). The Board acknowledged the improvements made and recommended continued monitoring and documentation of feedback implementation.
4. A proposal to integrate interdisciplinary courses into the curriculum was discussed. The Board approved the inclusion of relevant interdisciplinary components to promote holistic and cross-functional learning.
5. The Committee emphasized the importance of embedding cross-cutting themes such as ethics, gender sensitivity, environmental awareness, and human values across all programs. It was resolved to reflect these themes in course content and pedagogy.
6. A strategy for mapping courses to SDGs was presented. The Board appreciated the initiative and resolved to institutionalize SDG mapping across programs with proper documentation and periodic review.
7. The Committee reviewed the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA). It was resolved to pilot these reforms in selected courses and gradually expand their implementation.
