


Subject - Revise Institutional Ethical committee (IEC) clearance certificate for stroke registry project funded by ICMR.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Hospital Based Stroke Registries in India National Stroke Registry Programme ICMR-National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research, Bengaluru

The broad and overall objective of ICMR-National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research (ICMR-NCDIR), Bengaluru is to sustain and develop a national research data-base on cancer, diabetes, CVD, stroke, other NCDs and their risk factors through recent advances in electronic information technology with a national collaborative network, so as to undertake etiological, epidemiological, clinical and disease control research in these areas.

ICMR-NCDIR operates through a network of Population Based Stroke Registries (PBSRs) and Hospital Based Stroke Registries (HBSRs) across different parts of the country. The data collected enables to estimate stroke incidence, mortality, trends, burden, clinical management, outcome and survival. The information aids efforts towards stroke prevention and control in the country.

This Hospital Based Stroke Registries in India is being implemented by ICMR-NCDIR, Bengaluru at **Swami Rama Himalayan University, Dehradun** with the objective of generating reliable data on patterns of stroke and stroke care in different treatment settings in India.

The basic methodology for the project envisages capturing core patient information on demography, clinical details, risk factors, co-morbidities, treatment & discharge information, follow up details and outcome of all the cases of acute stroke reported/registered at all departments/units/sections who are involved in stroke diagnosis/treatment/care in the hospital.

Agreement for co-operation in the performance of work on "Hospital Based Stroke Registries in India" through ICMR-NCDIR, Bengaluru between Dr. Prashant Mathur, Director, ICMR-National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research, Bengaluru, hereinafter called Principal Investigator (PI) and

Dr. Deepak Goel hereinafter called Principal Investigator of Participating Centre (C-PI).



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The project sanction is up to September 2027, and it is effective from 1st April 2024. The funds will be released on installment basis based on quality of data submission and overall performance. The C-PI is responsible for the following:

1. Collection, collation and transmission of data of all first ever stroke reported from the above centre from the 1st January 2024 onwards.
2. Following terms and conditions (as specified in Annexure I) are necessary for uniformity and successful execution of study.
3. Managing funds provided for the said purpose as per guidance and rules applicable.
4. Submission of duly signed utilization certificate on a regular basis.

In consideration of the above, an annual budget of up to ₹ 5,00,000/- (Five Lakh only) per year is provided for the financial year 2024-25 and will be released in installments after receiving duly completed MOU and other codal formalities.
