SRHU Library System (Subscribed e-Resources)

Access is available with University IP Authentication or via – Knimbus (e-Library Portal),
through Remote Access for off-campus users



To access e-resources of the SRHU Library System, first, visit the library's website (<https://srhu.edu.in/libraries>).

Then, look for the "srhu.knimbus.com" or "Online Journals" section. You may need to log in with your library credentials or use IP-based access if you're on campus.

Steps to access e-resources:

1. Visit the library website:

Go to the official website of the central library.

2. Locate the URL (<https://srhu.edu.in/libraries>) or Online Journals

Find the section dedicated to electronic resources, often labeled "e-Resources" or "Online Journals".

3. Browse or search:

Browse the available e-resources by subject, type (e.g., e-journals, e-books), or search for specific titles or keywords.

4. Login (if required):

If you are accessing resources remotely, you may need to log in with your library credentials (username and password).

5. Utilize IP-based access:

If you are on campus, you may be able to access resources directly through the campus network's IP address range.

Additional Information:

Open Access Resources:

Many libraries also provide access to open access e-resources, which are freely available to everyone.

Remote Access:

Some libraries offer remote access facilities for subscribed e-resources, allowing users to access them from outside the campus network.

Fair Use:

Be sure to adhere to the library's usage guidelines and copyright restrictions when accessing and using e-resources.

Responsible Use Guidelines for Online Resources at [University/Institution Name] Library System

Purpose

The online resources offered by the SRHU Library System such as digital journals, research databases, and e-books—are made available exclusively for educational, research, and academic purposes by the university's students, faculty, and staff. Users are encouraged to explore, read, download, and print individual chapters or articles for personal academic work.

Restrictions

Downloading full books, entire journal issues, or large portions of databases in bulk is not permitted. Automated downloading tools—such as bots, crawlers, or similar software—must not be used. Excessive or systematic downloading can result in access suspension for the entire institution by the resource provider.

Licensing & Compliance

The library subscribes to these e-resources through direct agreements with publishers, vendors, and consortium partners. Each agreement includes specific terms of use, which may differ from one provider to another. Users are personally responsible for adhering to the relevant licensing conditions to ensure continued and lawful access to all subscribed resources.

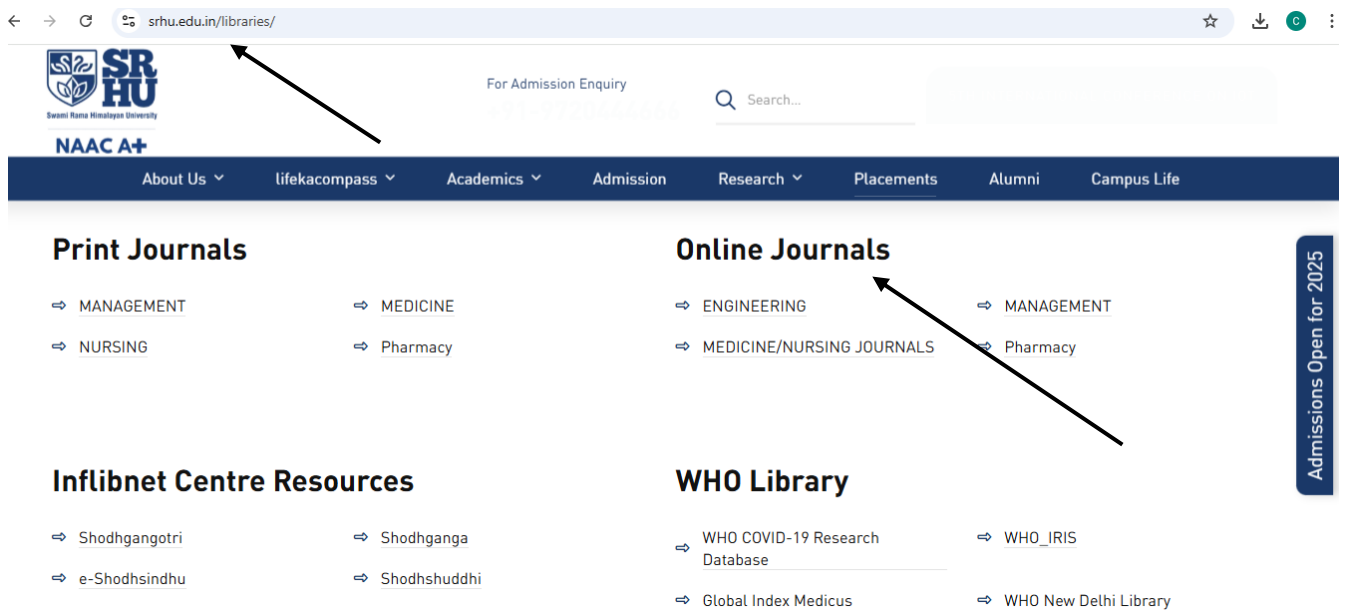


Figure 2. Arrow Indicating the Listing of e-Resources

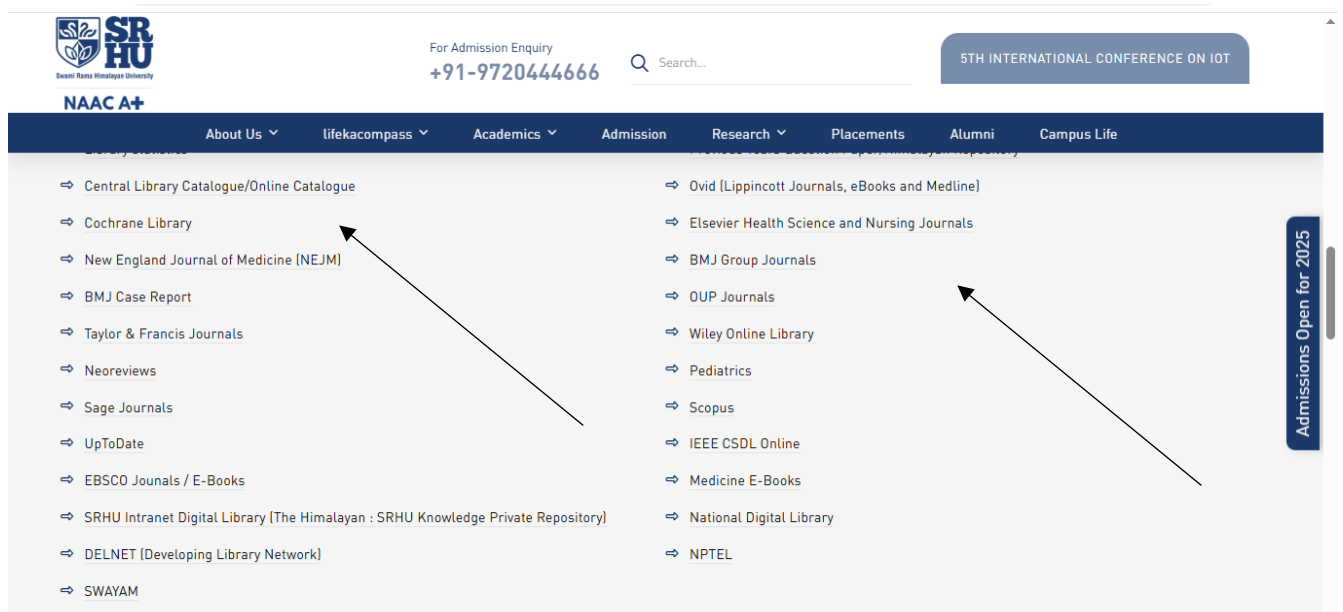


Figure 3. Indicating the URL for Remote Access Portal

SRHU's library services are one of the best among the private universities in India and are provided through SRHU Library System which comprises a Central Library located at HIMs and six faculty library centers located at HSMS, HSST, HCN, HSBS and HSYS and HSPS.

The Central Library of the University was established in 1992 as HIMs Central Library to support Medical, Paramedical and Nursing courses. It has now completed 32 years. It has around 3000 sm of space and a seating capacity of 425 users. The HCN Library was established in 1997 while HSST and HSMS libraries came into existence in 2013. Other library centres became functional in 2023 and 2024.

Main emphasis of the Library System is on digital services through latest ICT technology such as RFID, KOHA integrated LMS, Remote access to all its e-resources that ranges into several lakhs in number. The total strength of its monograph collection is more than 37,000, subscription to 2561 foreign journals (mostly e-journals) access to lakh of open access e-journals and e-books. Continuous information literacy programmes to optimize the use of e-resources and research management is the unique features of the Library System.

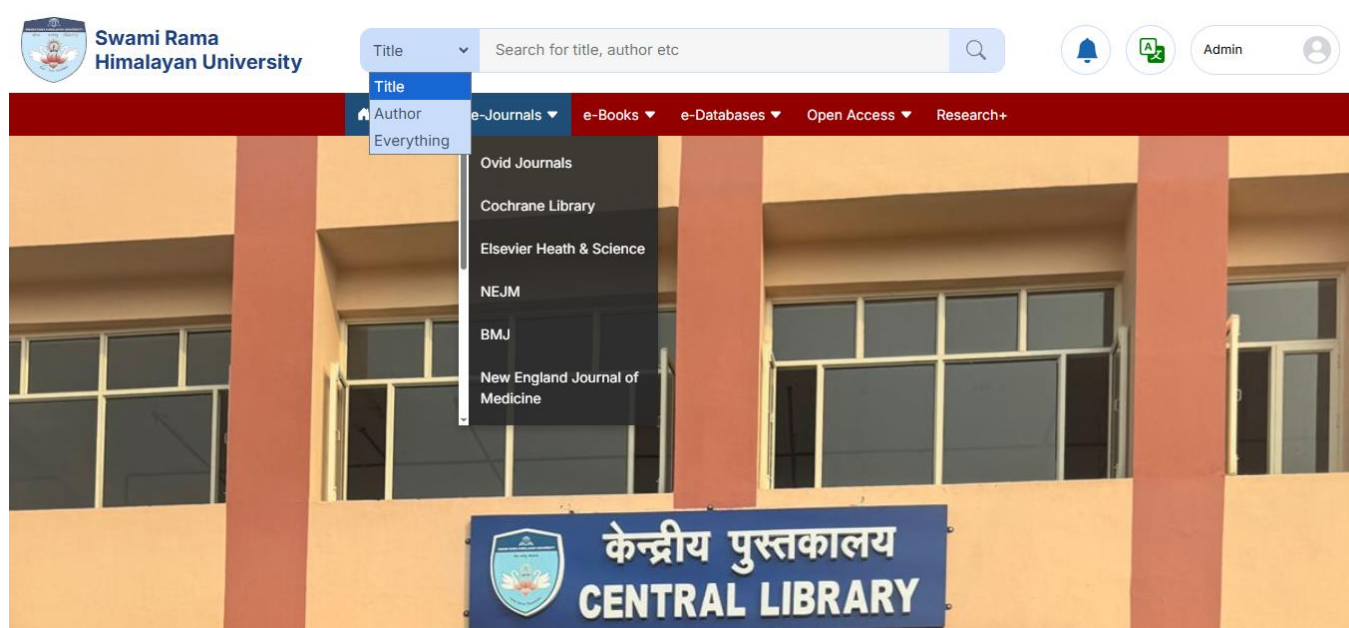
